<p>#1 - Scripture never contradicts Scripture</p> <p>#2 - never separate a portion of Scripture from its context</p> <p>#3 - God is a God of history - He wants us to know Him</p>	<p>Dan 9:27 - firm covenant for 1 week = 7 years - 3 1/2 years into it, he will break it</p> <p>7 seals - Rev 6:1-8:6</p> <p>7 trumpets - Rev 8:7-11:19</p> <p>3 1/2 years</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 witnesses - Dragon thrown to earth (12) - Anti-Christ begins persecution - directed at the Jews and Jerusalem (13) <p>7 bowls (16)</p> <p>Babylon judged (17-18)</p> <p>Marriage Supper of the Lamb (19:9-10)</p> <p>Christ appears victorious - strikes down those who oppose Him with the sword (19:11-16)</p> <p>Great Supper of God (19:17-21)</p> <p>Satan will be bound for 1,000 years (20:1-3)</p> <p>Millennial reign (20:4-6)</p> <p>Satan is released (20:7-10) - he comes to deceive and rebel against Jesus - Gog and Magog (8-9)</p> <p>fire comes from heaven to devour them</p> <p>Great White Throne Judgment (20:11-15)</p>	<p>Ez 28:25-26 - gather them together, to live in their land, God will judge the nations that scorned them - they will live securely</p> <p>Ez 34:23-31 - Jesus will rule over them, covenant of peace, harmful beasts will be gone, no more famine, they won't be prey, nations won't insult the Jews</p> <p>Jer 23:5-6 - Jesus will reign as King - and they will live securely</p> <p>Zech 14:9-11 - no more curse, Lord will be King - the Jews will live securely</p> <p>Ez 38:8, 11, 14 - they're in their own land living in peace, not afraid of people or war or animals - while they are living securely in peace Gog will come upon them</p> <p>Ez 39:26 - live securely after Gog's defeat</p>

<p>1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gog was the chief prince of the area of modern day Turkey - Gog will gather many people from all 4 directions <p>7-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - latter years they will come upon the land of Israel with the gathered people - The people will be living securely <p>10-13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gog thinks he will go plunder Israel - it has no defense - they are at rest and living securely - Other nations waiting to see what will happen <p>14-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - in the last days they will come on Israel - The nations will know that I am God <p>17-23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - great earthquake - All that is on the earth will shake at God's presence - God calls for a sword, enter into judgment - rain, hail, fire, brimstone 	<p>1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - judgment falls on Gog - They will fall in Israel - They will be given as food to every kind of bird and beast - God will send fire upon Magog <p>7-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - all the weapons will be gathered and burned - Burned the weapons for 7 years <p>11-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Israel will become a burial ground for Gog and his hordes - They will bury for 7 months to cleanse the land <p>17-20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You will be glutted with what has been brought as a sacrifice to you <p>21-24</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the nations will understand the big picture - Israel treated God wrongly - He gave them over to their enemies <p>25-29</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God will not hide from His people anymore - His Spirit will be poured out 	<p>- I Chron 5:1-4 - comes from Reuben's line</p> <p>Magog - Turkey Rosh = chief or prince (Ez 38:2) - high or supreme one</p> <p>Chief prince of the world (Satan) Represent anti-christ</p> <p>General title for enemy of God's people</p> <p>It is pointing to something future</p> <p>Could it be pointing to the battle of Armageddon at the end of the 7 years? Could it be pointing to the battle at the end of the Millennium? Could it be both?</p>
