<p>1-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1st month of the 2nd year - Observe the passover on the 14th day at twilight - Unclean? <p>9-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - even unclean or away can participate by observing on the 2nd month on the 14th day observing all the statutes - We need to be obedient all the time - If someone will not keep it as they should they are cut off (killed) - Aliens follow same laws <p>15-23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - cloud/fire were a visible sign of God's presence with them - Follow Me - go where I direct you to go - Need to sit quiet before Him and hear His voice 	<p>1-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Trumpets are made of silver - Hammered work - Abraham with Isaac - ram was caught in the thicket by his horns - reminder of God's substitutionary promise of one to die in our place - Coming together - Sounded for the camps to set out - Battle sound (alarm) - Aaron's sons - priests are to sound the trumpets <p>11-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2nd year, 2nd month, 20th day - Journeyed to Paran - Judah, Issachar, Zebulun (13-16) <p>17-20 - tabernacle with Gershon and Merari, followed by the south tribes</p> <p>21-24 - Kahathites with the holy objects - followed by the west tribes</p> <p>25-28 - North tribes</p> <p>29-32 - Moses's brother-in-law - Hobab - be our eyes (Judges 1:16)</p> <p>33-36 - Leave the mountain - the ark went before them</p>	<p>1-3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - loud outcry - God heard - God's anger was kindled - People cried to Moses - Moses cries out to God to stop consuming the people with fire <p>4-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - rabble - non-Israelites - greedy desires - We had much in Egypt - Appetite is gone <p>10-15</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses heard the complaining about the meat - Moses tells God I didn't ask for any of this - too much burden <p>16-23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God says I will give them meat 30 days - Is the Lord's power limited <p>24-25</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 70 elders given to help - They prophesied (praise and worship) <p>26-30 - Spirit put upon 2 elders that were in the camp</p> <p>31-35 - quail</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - homer = 60-70 bushels - They swarmed - the people gathered - God strikes them with a severe plague 	<p>1-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Miriam and Aaron spoke against the Cushite woman (1) - Miriam is most likely the instigator in this rebellion - Does God only speak to Moses (2) - God knows the heart (2-8) <p>9-15</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God strikes Miriam with leprosy - Moses wants Miriam restored - Miriam has to stay separated from the camp for 7 days

Spying Out the Land (13)	Refusing to Enter for Unbelief (14)	10 times they tested God	Delaying God's Blessing (15)
<p>1-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God called them to pick a leader from each tribe to spy out the land - Dt 1:22-23 - people requested this - Motivation - gain, size up their opponents, see if what God promised was true, didn't necessarily trust God to do what He said - 12 spies that are chosen (Caleb - from Judah, Joshua from Ephraim - Joshua = the Lord is salvation) <p>17-20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - what is the land like - People - strong or weak, many or few - Land good or bad - Cities open or fortified - Land fat or lean, are there trees - Get some fruit - mid to late July <p>21-24 - they see land and bring fruit</p> <p>25-29 - Report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the people are big and strong - Cities are fortified - There are people living there <p>30-33</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Caleb - we can go - God is with us - Other men - people are too strong - Gave a bad report - exaggerated the dangers of the land, they instilled fear into the people - They are causing the people to lose their faith in God's provision and promise - Inciting the people to rebellion 	<p>1-4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - people grumbled at Moses and God - God brought us here to kill - their wives and children would become plunder - Appoint a leader to take them back to Egypt <p>5-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Joshua and Caleb mourn for the people's rebellion - The land is good - God will bring us into it - Congregation wanted to stone them <p>11-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses pleads with God - wanting God's name to be glorified among the nations - Calls on God's qualities (attributes) - lovingkindness, forgiveness, mercy <p>20-25 - God's punishment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I will pardon - but they will pay for their sins - No man who has seen God's glory will enter the land - They are going to be turned out into the wilderness instead of the Promised Land <p>26-35</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God will destroy the numbered men in the wilderness as they wander for 40 years - Wicked congregation who grumbled against Him and rejected the land <p>36-38 - the 10 spies die by plague</p> <p>39-45 - they decide they wanted a "do over" and go to take the land</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they are beaten down for God is not with them 	<p>Numbers 14:22-23</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Ex 14:10-12 - Pharaoh's army 2) Ex 15:22-24 - bitter waters 3) Ex 16:1-3 - no food 4) Ex 16:19-20 - leaving manna til morning 5) Ex 16:27-30 - not gathering extra manna on 6th day 6) Ex 17:1-4 - no water 7) Ex 32:1-35 - golden calf 8) Num 11:1-3 - complaining before the Lord 9) Num 11:4-34 - wanting meat to eat 10) Num 14:3 - bemoaning not going into the promised land
