<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A Benjamite</li> <li>- Son of Kish</li> <li>- Family of wealth and influence</li> <li>- Handsome and tall</li> <li>- Lost donkeys = lost wealth</li> <li>- Kish sent Saul to look for the donkeys</li> <li>- The servant suggested going to see the seer (prophet - Samuel)</li> <li>- Saul finds Samuel and goes to eat with him at a sacrifice</li> <li>- Samuel has a place of honor for Saul - gives him a place to sleep and sends him away in the morning</li>   <li>- Lord chose Saul to be the leader of Israel</li> <li>- Samuel anoints him with oil - sets him apart for God's service</li> <li>- Spirit of the Lord will come on him and he will become like another man</li> </ul>
