| Wickedness of man was great (5) <br> Every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually (5) <br> - 1600 years man invented all kinds of evil <br> - Jealousy, murder, arrogance, polygamy <br> - Evil brings forth more evil -it puffs up, evil permeates everything it touches <br> Lord was sorry He had made man (KJV it repented the Lord) <br> - heart was grieved (6) <br> - Num 23:19; I Sam 15:29God does not repent, He does not change His mind <br> - Uses human terminology to try to explain God's thoughts <br> - God was sorrowful, grieved over what sin has done to His perfect creation <br> God would blot out man (and animals) from the face of the land (7) <br> - total destruction to God's creation <br> - God's patience (human terms) had run out <br> - Sin brings about destruction (Ro 6:23) | Sons of God are contrasted to daughters of men <br> - women beautiful, fair <br> - Took wives from the daughters of men - whomever they choose <br> - Took = \#H3947 take, get, fetch, lay hold of, seize, buy, marry, take a wife, snatch, take away from <br> Sons of God <br> - Angelic being (fallen) <br> - Godly line of people versus ungodly - Seth/Cain <br> - Rulers/kings | God's Spirit wouldn't strive with man forever <br> - Holy Spirit's job - convicts of sin, helper, comforter, teacher of truth, calls to repentance, causes us to walk in His ways <br> - He was calling people to repentance and righteousness through men like Noah and Enoch (II Peter 2:5; Jude 14-15) <br> Man's days will be 120 years <br> - I Peter 3:20-time span before the flood <br> - Man was given opportunity to respond to God's warnings God is patient - His patience only lasts so long <br> - Could be man's lifespan dramatically drops after the flood | Nephilim (KJV - giants) - <br> \#H5303 - Nephil - a bully or tyrant, also be translated giant <br> From the root word \#H5307 - to fall <br> Also used in Numbers 13:30-33 - the sons of Anak are part of the Nephilim - we were grasshoppers in their sight <br> Dt 29:29 - we will not know the secret things of God! <br> Nephelim were on the earth in those days and also afterward when the sons and daughters were there <br> The mighty men seem to be the offspring <br> Giants <br> Nephilim (Gen 6:4; Num 13:30-33) <br> I Sam 17 - Goliath from Gath <br> II Sam 21:20-22 - have 4 other sons <br> Dt 3:11-Og of Rephaim - bed was 13.5 by 6 feet <br> Rephaim \#H7495-giant <br> Anak - \#H6060 - a tribe of giant people in Canaan |

## Fallen Angels

## Theory

- fallen angels (spirits/demons/those who fell with Satan) intermarried with the daughters of men
- Wickedness of unlawful marriage - take on human male body

- Job 1:6-12; 2:1; 38:7
- II Pet 2:4-10; Jude 6-7 - angels that didn’t keep their proper place but came to the earth (II Pet 2:4?)(Rev 20:1-3; 7-10)

Problems

- Mt 22:30 - angels don't marry or given or marriage - fornication?
- Sons of God seem to be the instigator of sin - punish men?
- Sets the stage for mythology
- Acts 17:26; Ro 5:15-21 - from one man came all men - through one man came all sin - would this bypass the line of Adam and sins seed?

Sons of God - godly vs ungodly
Theory

- godly line of Seth
- Daughters of men were the evil line of Cain
- Sin would have been the righteous marrying the unrighteous

Support

- Seth was appointed as a replacement for Abel (Seth was righteous?)
- Cain was driven away because of his sin
- Matt 5:9; Romans 8:14, 19; 9:26, Gal 3:26-believers
