<p>Sovereignty of God (Dan)</p> <p>Establishes kings and kingdoms and tears them down</p> <p>God is able to humble those who walk in pride (Dan 4:37)</p> <p>Pr 8:13 - God hates pride - we make ourselves God, we put I on the throne</p> <p>James 4:6 - God is opposed to the proud but gives grace to the humble</p>	<p>God gave him his kingdom</p> <p>He was warned by Daniel to repent</p> <p>Didn't truly repent of his pride</p> <p>Exalted himself (4)</p> <p>God humbled him (4)</p> <p>Recognized God as the ruler and as sovereign</p> <p>God restored him to his former power</p> <p>Praise and worship came from Neb</p>	<p>Arrogant - filled with pride</p> <p>He knew everything that happened to Neb and yet was not humbled</p> <p>He was honoring the gods of silver and gold, but refusing to honor God</p> <p>Exalting himself over God</p> <p>Pr 16:18 - pride comes before destruction</p> <p>Humility is a right thinking about yourself</p> <p>God put an end to his kingdom</p> <p>Gave the kingdom to the Medes and the Persians</p>	<p>Obedience to God</p> <p>Humility</p> <p>Speak honestly, truthfully, compassionately</p> <p>Fear of God more than man</p> <p>His life of humility brought glory and praise to God alone</p>	<p>Is 45:1-13</p> <p>God raised him up (God's anointed)</p> <p>God was going to use him to free His people to rebuild the temple (Is 44:28)</p> <p>Even though he did not acknowledge God - God used him to accomplish His purpose</p>
