<p>Is 64:6 - unclean, righteous deeds are like filthy rags, wither away</p> <p>Eph 2:8-9 - it is grace through faith that saves and not our works</p> <p>Ro 8:9 - if you don't have the Spirit of God in you, you don't belong to Him</p> <p>Ro 9:30-32 - righteousness comes through true faith</p> <p>Gal 3:2, 5, 10 - faith saves not the works of the law</p>	<p>Matt 3:1-3 - repent the kingdom of heaven is at hand (Jesus)</p> <p>Luke 13:3 - unless you repent you will perish</p> <p>Acts 2:38 - repent and be baptized - for forgiveness of your sins</p> <p>Acts 20:17-21 - repentance toward God and faith in Christ</p> <p>Acts 26:15-20 - turned from darkness to light, from the dominion of Satan to God, receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance</p>
<p>Our State</p> <p>Ro 5:12 - all have sinned</p> <p>Eph 2:1-3 - dead in sins, walked in the power of Satan, lusts of flesh, indulging the flesh and the mind, by nature we were children of wrath</p> <p>Heb 9:14 - cleansed from our dead works to serve the living God</p>

<p>people need to move on in their Christian walk - they need to mature (6:1-3)</p> <p>6:4-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Heb 3:12 - evil, unbelieving heart that falls away - apostate - one who has heard and is unwilling to unite with faith - have once been enlightened - have tasted the heavenly gifts - have been made partakers of the Holy Spirit - have tasted the good word of God and the powers to come - then have fallen away - aorist participles - a simple action not a continuous action 	<p>5:13 - you can know that you have eternal life (John 20:30-31)</p> <p>1:9 - confessing of sins</p> <p>1:10 - if we say that we have no sin, we make God out to be a liar</p> <p>2:2 - Jesus is the satisfaction - He paid for our salvation</p> <p>2:3 - we know Him if we keep His commandments</p> <p>2:6 - walk like Jesus walked (Matt 5-7)</p> <p>2:10 - love our brethren</p> <p>2:15 - don't love the world and things of the world</p> <p>2:19 - faithful to the end</p> <p>2:23-24 - confess Jesus and abide in Him (John 15:1-6)</p> <p>3:6 - no one who abides in Jesus sins (present tense - habitual lifestyle) Repent from a life of sin</p> <p>4 - showing love to our brothers, confessing Jesus, there is no fear in our lives - perfect love casts out fear</p> <p>5:5-12 - believe that Jesus is the Son of God, that He died for our sins, and eternal life is in Him alone</p>	<p>Matt 13:4-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - seed fell beside road - birds ate it - rocky places - sprang up but had no root and died - thorns - thorns choked them out - good soil - produced fruit <p>Matt 13:18-23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - road - heard, had no understanding, Satan snatched it away - rocky places - hears word, receives with joy - temporary - when bad things happen they walk away - thorns - worry of the world, deceitfulness of wealth choke it - unfruitful - good soil - hears and understands - bears fruit
