Riots * shootings * unrest * terrorism * divisions financial instability * earthquakes * droughts * floods sink holes * Covid * superbugs * weaponized viruses global warming * war * nuclear weapons 100s of millions of unborn children murdered

Are these signs that the end is coming?

- ~ more apocalyptic movies and tv shows are produced and watched now than ever before
- ~ as of 2018 (things have increased since then)
 - 957 movies 67% since 2000
 - 88 TV shows 66% since 2000
- ~ everyone realizes that something has to give . . . or break!

- 3. Want to encourage you if you are a true follower of Jesus Christ
 - time of excitement not fear
 - time to wake up there is an urgency to share God's word be a watchman on the wall
- 4. If you are not a true follower of Jesus Christ or you are not sure what that means
 - we want to be the watchman on the wall
 - judgment is coming and you need to be ready
 - Jesus said (John 14:6) "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me."
 - no other path leads to salvation but the atoning work that Jesus Christ did when He died on the cross for you
 - It's not by works
 - It's not by the church you go to
 - It's not by becoming good enough
 - It's not the family you were born in or the country that you live in
 - When you put your complete faith in Jesus Christ then you will know that you have eternal life (I John 5:13)

Foundational Premise

- 1. There is one God, maker of heaven and earth
- 2. The Bible is His Word to man
 - every word is inspired of God
 - if there is confusion, misunderstandings, or seeming contradictions
 - to go back to the original languages
 - put the passage into its cultural setting
- 3. It is true from cover to cover
- 4. It needs to be read and understood literally. We take it at face value it means what it says
- 5. Good Bible study is inductive Bible study allows Scripture to speak for itself Scripture interprets Scripture

3 Steps

- Observation studying it, allowing God to speak to us through it
- Interpretation
 - there is only one way to interpret a passage of Scripture
 - it means what the author, inspired by God, intended it to mean when it was penned and given to the recipients
 - not open to man's own interpretation (II Peter 1:20)
 - it is the word of truth it is God's truth
- Application innumerable ways to apply God's Word to your life



What two books of the Bible are the most disputed?

There are many people, pastors, and churches that don't want to touch prophecy it's taboo it's divisive it's impossible to understand

Why should we study prophecy?

- 1. Compelling evidence that God is who He says He is
 - events foretold in precise detail have been fulfilled
 - supernatural in nature
 - can see His work and His power everywhere we look
- 2. 30% of the Bible is prophecy
 - a lot to ignore if prophecy scares or intimidates you
 - 50-80% has been fulfilled the rest is coming
- 3. We know what happens to those who have rejected God and His Son, Jesus Christ - should motivate us to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ
- 4. We know the end of the story it should give us hope and encouragement and allow us to live victoriously through anything that comes
- 5. 109 Messianic prophecies 109 separate and distinct prophecies about Jesus' first coming exact timing, conditions, lineage, place of birth, place of escape, ministry, death, burial, resurrection
 - hundreds or thousands of years before His birth
 - probability of one person fulfilling 4 of the 109 would be 1 in 10 trillion
 - One person fulfilling 48 1 followed by 156 zeros





Are there benefits to studying prophecy?

- 1. Growing in spiritual maturity knowing God and Jesus Christ in a real and personal way
- 2. Give us a desire to share Christ with others
- 3. Helps us to view life with an eternal perspective to see today in the big picture of History
- 4. Help us to live out our convictions each and every day not knowing when our Lord may come
- 5. Blessing that is promised (Rev 1:3; 22:7) only book of the Bible that promises a blessing for hearing and heeding its words



- 4. He doesn't want you to be prepared for the battle that is coming
- 5. He wants you defeated, scared, unfruitful, and complacent

The question is - Are you going to let him win?



Definitions

- 1. <u>Church</u> the body of believers made up of true followers of Jesus Christ
- 2. <u>Church age</u> the period of time when Christ's church lives and ministers on earth
- 3. <u>**Rapture</u>** the catching up or gathering together of believers to meet the Lord in the air</u>
- 4. <u>**Tribulation**</u> a time of great trouble and persecution that will last for 7 years and directed at those who have forsaken God, specifically the Jews
- 5. <u>Millennium</u> 1000 year time period of peace when Christ will rule on the earth
- 6. <u>Anti-christ</u> the man of Lawlessness, the beast the one who will blaspheme God and will demand worship of himself, alone
- 7. <u>False Prophet</u> the spiritual advisor to the anti-christ who will cause all mankind to worship the image of the beast and receive his mark
- 8. <u>Apocalypse</u> usually referred to as the end of the world, destruction, judgment in Scripture it means the "revealing" or "the unveiling"
- 9. <u>Armageddon</u> a physical place where the armies will gather to make war against God and the Son
- <u>Eternal state</u> eternity future the New Heaven, Earth, Jerusalem the old has been destroyed. It also refers to where man will spend his eternity - in the New Heaven - or outside where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth - in the fire that never consumes or destroys

<u>4 Views of Prophetic Interpretation</u>

- 1. <u>Idealist</u> prophecy is all symbolic it becomes man's interpretation
- 2. **<u>Preterist</u>** the prophecies have already happened
- 3. <u>Historicist</u> prophecy is just an overview of history
- 4. <u>Futurist</u> since prophecies happened exactly as spoken in Christ's first coming prophecy will again be fulfilled exactly as Scripture says in the future

The first 3 views interpret Scripture figuratively - allegorizes or spiritualizes - if we can allegorize portions of Scriptures - we can allegorize any we choose

Only the last one interprets Scripture literally

3 Views of the Rapture

- 1. <u>**Pre-Trib(ulation)**</u> The church will be taken out of this world before the 7 years of tribulation
- <u>Mid-Trib</u> Many events happen at the mid point of the 7 years at 3 1/2 years - one of those events would be the church taken out of the world
- 3. <u>**Post-Trib**</u> The believers will be gathered with Jesus at the end of the 7 years and then return with Him when He comes at the end of the tribulation

3 Views of the Millennium

- 1. <u>Amillennialism</u> It is a symbolic time that describes the church age
- 2. <u>Postmillennialism</u> Jesus will come back after the millennium tribulation period is just symbolic of the difficult times we experience on the earth
- Premillennialism will be a literal 1000 year kingdom come to earth after the 7 year tribulation and before Satan is released for a short time - Jesus will rule and reign

7 Dispensations

dispensation = a system of order especially as existing at a particular period of time - the way something works within a given context as God relates to mankind







- Daniel was written in the dispensational time period of the Law
- certain things were sealed up and not known until the time was right
- As we move into the time of grace - those prophecies that were sealed up are now becoming evident
- As we move through Scripture we need to keep in mind when it had been written and what was understood during that time period
