<p>1-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- change of command - Moses to Joshua</li> <li>- Be strong and courageous</li> <li>- God is going before them</li> </ul> <p>9-13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Moses writes these laws and gives them to the sons of Levi</li> <li>- Every 7 years, they are to be read to everyone at the Feast of Booths</li> <li>- They were to hear and learn to fear the Lord</li> </ul> <p>14-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Moses will die, they will go into the land</li> <li>- They will forsake God and serve the gods of the land</li> <li>- His anger will burn and He will hide His face from them</li> </ul> <p>19-22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Moses is to write a song</li> <li>- It is a reminder of what the people did after God took care of them</li> </ul> <p>23 - God commissioned Joshua</p> <p>24-30</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- this book was to be beside the ark</li> <li>- It was a witness against them</li> </ul>	<p>1-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- call to pay attention</li> <li>- Starts by honoring God</li> <li>- God is their rock - strength, durable, stable, permanent (Mt 7:24-27)</li> <li>- They are a perverse and crooked generation - contrasted against the Rock (Mt 17:17; Phil 2:15)</li> <li>- He is their Father - remember how He has protected you</li> </ul> <p>15-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Jeshurun - "upright one" - #H3484</li> <li>- Live up to your name!</li> <li>- Instead of thankfulness they became rebellious</li> <li>- Idol worship = demon worship</li> </ul> <p>19-22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God turned away from them</li> <li>- Those who are not a nation/foolish nation (Gentile nations) - God will use to make His people jealous (Ro 11)</li> </ul> <p>23-33</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- enemies will come in war</li> <li>- They assumed that God would keep on protecting them no matter what</li> </ul>
