Jephthah (11-12) - Valiant warrior and the son of a harlot (1) - Brothers drove him out (2) - Worthless men gathered with him (3) - He was put in position as head of Gilead (11) - Tries to reason with the king of Ammon (12) - History lesson (15-26) - Spirit of the Lord comes upon him (29)	Vows Gen 28:20-22; 31:13 Num 30 - bound by the vows we make Lev 22:17-25 - vows were sealed with an offering Ecc 5:1-7 - don't be hasty in word or impulsive in thought but bring the matter before the Lord - Let your words be few (fools use many words)
 He makes an unnecessary vow - manipulate God (30-40) If we win - then I will offer (31) Burnt offerings - made by the priests for atonement (Lev 1:3-9) No place for human sacrifice (Dt 18:10) 	 Don't be late in paying a vow Ps 15:2 walks in integrity Works righteousness Speaks truth in his heart Lev 27
