I Cor 14

- prophecy is important (1)
- Prophecies are spoken to edify, exhort, and console men (3)
- Edifies the church (4) (cf. Rom 14:19 definition of edify)
- Seeking to edify the church (12)
- Prophecy is a sign for those who believe (22)
- Prophecy convicts those who are unbelievers (24)
- 2 or 3 can prophesy and others are to pass judgment (29)
- God is not a God of confusion but of peace (31-33)
- All things are to be don properly and in orderly manner (40)

Old Testament

- Dt 13:1-5
 - Needs to prophesy the Lord's words
 - Can't encourage rebellion against the Lord
 - Don't listen to that prophet, but remain faithful to the Lord
- Dt 18:20-22
 - If the prophet speaks something that doesn't come true, then he is not speaking the word of the Lord
- Jer 28:9-17
 - We need to listen to truth the one who brings the message of truth needs to be the one we follow
