IT'S NOT FAIR!

We think we can tell God what to do

We forget our place - He's God, we're not

ls 29:15-16

- the potter is not equal to the clay
- the clay can't tell the potter what to do

ls 45

- He is God and there is no other
- the clay can't say to the potter, what are you doing?

Jer 18:1-17

- the potter has the right to remake the clay
- It's hopeless we want to follow our own plans
- we act according to the stubbornness of our evil heart

Romans 9

- there is no injustice with God
- Judges 1; 2:20-23 they could not drive them out because they would not drive them out
- God has the right to make vessels of honor and dishonor from the same lump of clay
- we purse righteous through faith not through works
- they stumble over Jesus
