<p>Gal 5:19-21</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - deeds of the flesh - Get rid of these - Idolaters will not inherit the kingdom of God (I Cor 6:9; Eph 5:5; Rev 21:8; 22:15) <p>Col 3:5-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - greed amounts to idolatry - God's wrath will fall on those who walk in these sins <p>I Sam 15:23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - insubordination is the same as idolatry - arrogance and pride - worshiping of self instead of God <p>Is 2:8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they worshipped the work of their hands <p>Worship = the act of praising, giving of our time, money, resources, thoughts, talents</p> <p>Idolatry = worshipping anything other than God - anything that takes our time, or take the place that God rightfully deserves in our life - wanting something more than we want God</p>	<p>Ex 20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - no other gods (3) - Don't make an image or serve it (4-5) - He is a jealous God (5) - Not take His name in vain (7) - Sabbath day (8) <p>Ez 6:9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - our idolatry hurts God's heart - They will loathe themselves for the evil they do <p>I Cor 10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - OT stories happened for us to learn from - don't make the same mistakes (6,11) - Flee from idolatry (14) - Cannot partake of demons and Christ (21) <p>I Cor 8:4-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - there is only one God - there is only one way to get to God (Jn 14:6) 	<p>Ez 23</p> <p>Oholah - Northern tribes - Israel</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - played harlot (5) - Lusted after Assyria (5) - Wanted what they had (6) - Defiled herself with the idols (7) - God gave her over to the Assyrians (9) - They took her sons and daughters and slew her with the sword (10) <p>Oholibah - Southern tribes - Judah</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - saw what happened (11) - Acted even worse (11) - Increased her harlotries (14-15) - God gave her to the Babylonians (22) 	<p>They were asked to bow - worship - called to idolatry</p> <p>They refused to bow down - it was not their God, they knew their God and what he had done for them</p> <p>They loved God - they knew His commands</p> <p>They knew it could cost them their lives</p> <p>They knew God could deliver them - they also knew that if he didn't, they still wouldn't bow (17-18)</p> <p>Rev 13</p> <p>Idols today</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Entertainment - Work - TV/Commercials - want the things of the world (lack of satisfaction in God) - alcohol/drugs - Friends - wrong kind - Family - Social media/phones - Money - Hobbies - Sports/music - Greed
