<p>God made the promise to Abraham Gen 12:1-3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - land - Great nation - blessing - all the families of the earth will be blessed through him <p>Gen 15</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a descendant from his own body - multitude of descendants - enslaved for 400 years in a land not their own - God will judge that nation - come out with many possessions <p>Gal 3:16 - Christ is the promised seed of Abraham</p> <p>Abraham Isaac (Gen 26:1-5) Jacob (Gen 28:10-22)</p> <p>Gen 32:24-30 - Jacob's name is changed to Israel 12 sons = 12 tribes of Israel</p> <p>Joseph - sold into slavery - goes to Egypt Joseph 2nd in command of Egypt Joseph's family (Israel) come to Egypt Ex 1:8-14 - Israel became slaves</p> <p>Promise of Salvation</p>	<p>If they obey, then God will bless (Ex 19:5)</p> <p>Conditional covenant - not permanent</p> <p>Moses was the mediator (E 24:12) The Covenant of the Law</p> <p>Exodus 25-27 - God gives them the structure of the tabernacle</p> <p>(See picture on other page)</p> <p>Picture of Salvation</p>	<p>Jer 31:31-34 - New covenant with house of Israel and Judah</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - law will be put within them on their heart - He will be their God and they His people - They will know God <p>Jer 32:37-44 Jer 17:4</p> <p>Heb 8 Old Covenant is obsolete - ready to disappear</p> <p>1:25 (2:12) - law of liberty 2:8 - royal law</p> <p>Fulfillment of Salvation</p>

Coming into the Presence of God Through Jesus Christ

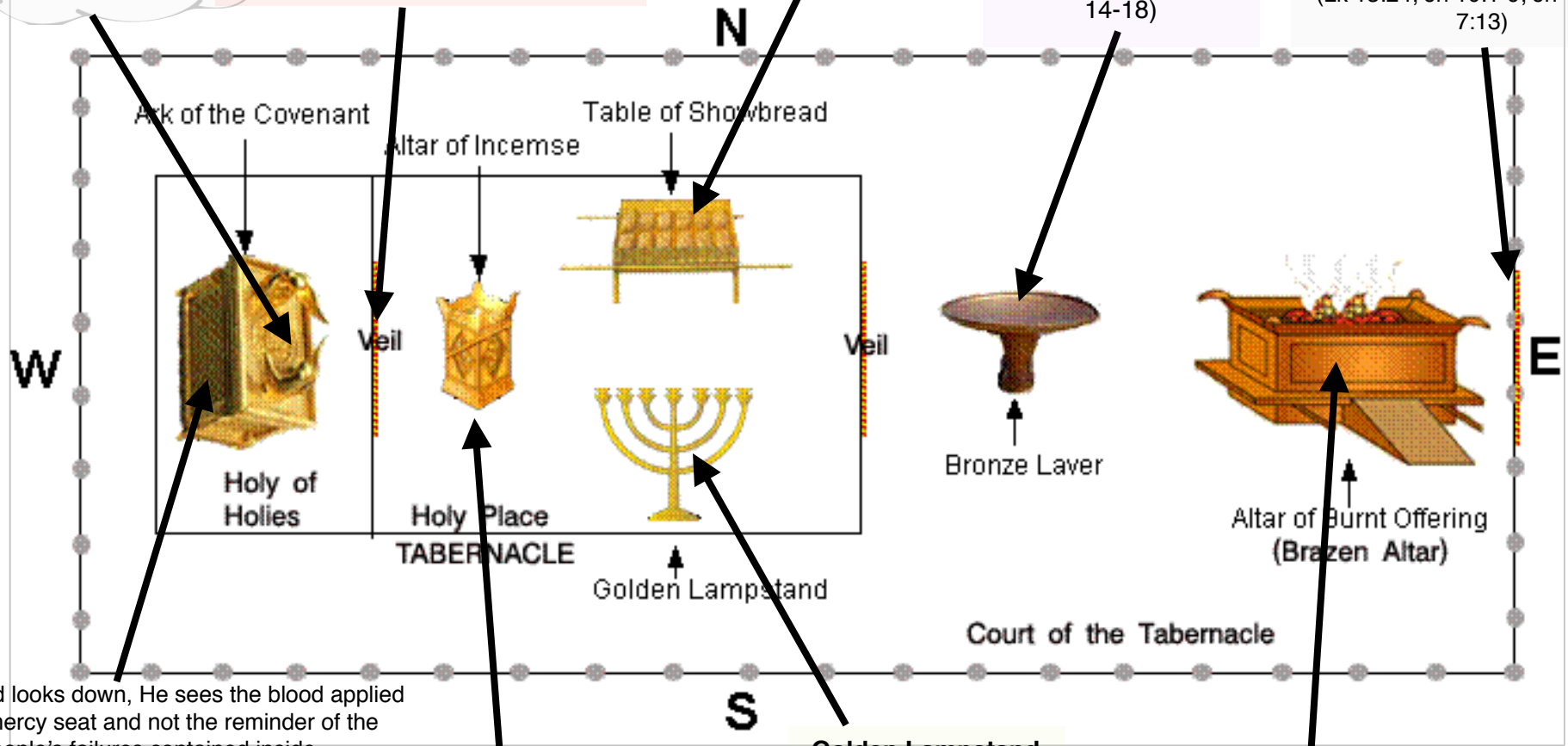
Veil - Christ's flesh that was torn in two from top to bottom - His body, the sacrifice, that was split in two so we could walk between the pieces and enter into God's presence. (He 10:19-22; Mt 27:51; Jn 1:29; Gen 15:9-21; He 10:19)

Table of Showbread
Jesus says I AM the Bread of Life (Jn 6:35, 51)

The Laver
We are to be washed in the water of the word - the Word is God come in flesh - Jesus Christ (Eph 5:26; Jn 1:1, 14-18)

The Door
We come into God's presence through the door. Jesus is the door. We come in one way - the Way that was prescribed by God Himself - any other attempt in our own power or own way is called the wide way that leads to death (Lk 13:24; Jn 10:1-9; Jn 14:6; Mt 7:13)

Presence of God appeared over mercy seat



When God looks down, He sees the blood applied to the mercy seat and not the reminder of the people's failures contained inside.

Tablets - peoples' rejection of God's laws
Jar of Manna - peoples' rejection of God's provision
Aaron's Rod - peoples' rejection of God's authority

Golden Altar of Incense
Prayers of the saints are a soothing aroma (incense) before the God. Jesus is the mediator who takes those prayers before the Lord. He is the One who intercedes on our behalf. (Ps 141:2; Rev 5:8; Rev 8:3-4; 1 Tim 2:5; Rom 8:27, 34)

Golden Lampstand
Jesus says I AM the Light of the World (Jn 8:12; 9:5; 1:9-13)

Bronze Altar
In order to come into God's presence there needs to be a sacrifice - male, unblemished, perfect sacrifice - the Lamb of God (Jn 1:29)
