Call to Abram (Gen 11:27-12:3)	Abram's Response (Gen 12:4-20)	Problems with Lot (13-14:16)	Melchizedek (14:17-24)
<p>Genealogy (11:24-29) Sarah is barren (11:30) Terah took Abram, Sarai, Lot - left Ur to enter Canaan</p> <p>Is 51:1-2 - God called Abraham, he was one, but God blessed him</p> <p>Acts 7:1-5 - God appeared to Abraham while in Ur, before getting to Haran - call came before they ever left</p> <p>He 11:8 - he obeyed and followed where God was leading</p> <p>Gen 12:1 - leave his country, his relatives, his father's house and go to the land God will show</p> <p>Promises</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- great nation (12:2)</li> <li>- Will be blessed</li> <li>- Name will be great</li> <li>- Will be a blessing</li> <li>- Bless those who bless/ curse those who curse (12:3)</li> <li>- All the families of earth will be blessed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 75 yrs old goes out of his land, Lot went with him (4)</li> <li>- Takes all his possessions and traveled to Canaan, Shechem (5-6)</li> <li>- Bethel, Ai, Negev - this will be his land (7-9) - built an altar</li> <li>- Famine in the land - travel to Egypt (10-16)</li> <li>- Concern - Sarai is beautiful - asks Sarai to say she is his sister for his safety</li> <li>- God steps in and plagues strike pharaoh's house (17)</li> <li>- He escorts them out of Egypt (18-20)</li> </ul>	<p>Chapter 13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Abram returns to the the land of his sojourning (1-4)</li> <li>- More animals than the land can support (5-7)</li> <li>- They separate and Lot chose the well watered land - Sodom and Gomorrah - Abram settles in Canaan (8-12)</li> <li>- Men of Sodom were exceedingly wicked (13)</li> </ul> <p>God's promises to Abram (14-18)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- all the land you see will be yours and your descendants</li> <li>- Descendants will be like the dust of the earth</li> <li>- Moved to Hebron and built an altar</li> </ul> <p>Chapter 14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- battle of 4 kings against 5 - Sodom and Gomorrah were captured - Lot was taken with all he had (1-12)</li> <li>- Abram and his men go get Lot back (13-16)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- king of Salem (peace)(18)</li> <li>- Also means righteous king</li> <li>- King-priest of ancient Jerusalem</li> <li>- Honored by the king of Sodom</li> <li>- Honored by Abram - gave him a tenth</li> <li>- Priest of the God Most High (El Elyon - Sovereign God - possessor of heaven and earth)</li> <li>- Blessed Abram (19)</li> </ul> <p>Ps 110:4 - Jesus? Is a priest for ever according to the order of Melchizedek (He 5:5-6)</p> <p>He 6:19-7:22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Jesus entered as a high priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek</li> <li>- King of righteousness and king of peace (2)</li> <li>- Without father and mother - no genealogy</li> <li>- No beginning of days nor end of life</li> <li>- Made like the Son of God</li> <li>- He remains a priest perpetually (3)</li> </ul>
