<p>Chapter 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sanctified, obey Christ (2) - Living hope (3) - Protected by the power of God (5) - Rejoicing when tested - to result in praise, glory, and honor to God (6-9) - Minds are to be prepared for action, sober in spirit, hope is set on the grace (13) - Obedient, not conformed to lusts (14) - Be holy (15) - Fearing God (17) - Bought with the blood of the Lamb (18-19) - Sincere, fervent love for others (22) <p>I Peter 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Taking off the old self - Putting on the new - longing for God's Word (1-2) - Spiritual house - offering spiritual sacrifices (5) - Chosen, priesthood, holy nation, God's possession (9) - Proclaiming His excellencies (9) - Walking in light (truth) (9) - Abstain from lusts (11) - Keep your behavior excellent (12) - Submit to authorities, doing what is right (13-17) - Submit to master, doing what is right (18-20) - Suffer for Christ following His example (21-23) - Trusting ourselves into the hands of the Righteous Judge (23) - Die to sin and live to righteousness (24) 	<p>Wives - in the same way as what (I Peter 2:13-25)</p> <p>Submitting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - with all respect - Even to those who are harsh - Endure even when suffering unjustly - Following Christ's example <p>Be subject to your own husband</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - if they are disobedient #G544 (not to allow one's self to be persuaded, refuse belief and obedience, to disbelieve willfully and perversely) - Purpose - so they may be won without a word, by the behavior of their wives as the observe the purity of your life and reverence for God (1-2) - Work on the person of the heart - gentle (meek and humble) and quiet (Character of action and reaction to her husband and life in general) spirit (3-4) - Sarah being subject to Abraham (5-6) - You are her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear (6) - We must obey God rather than man (Acts 4:18-20; 5:17-42) <p>Husbands</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - in the same way - attitude of submission (Eph 5:21-33) - Live with wives in an understanding way (sensitive to needs, fears, feelings - his needs need to be subordinate to hers) - Someone weaker - need of protection, provision, strength - Fellow heir of the grace of life (Ec 9:9) - closest earthly relationship that you can have (best) - husband needs to cultivate companionship and fellowship - So your prayers won't be hindered

Submission and Attitude (8-12)	Suffering for Righteousness (13-22)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - be harmonious #G3675 - be of the same mind - example of peace - Sympathetic - Loving - phileo - loving like a brother - companion love - Compassionate - tender hearted - Humble - Not returning evil or insult - Give a blessing instead - to speak well of - find a way to serve others while praying for his salvation or spiritual progress, expressing thankfulness for him, desiring their well being - You might inherit a blessing - we need to give the gift of forgiveness as we were given the gift of God's grace - keep our tongue from evil and deceit - Turn away from evil and do good - Seek peace and pursue it <p>The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous God hears their prayers God's face is against those who do evil</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - be zealous to do good (13) You are blessed for suffering for righteousness (14) - Sanctify Christ as Lord (Master) in your hearts (15) - lovingly obey Him in submission - Be ready to make a defense for hope with gentleness and respect (15) - Defense = Greek - apologetics - we must understand what we believe and how to communicate it to others humbly, thoughtfully, reasonably, and Biblically - Keep a good conscience (16) - conscience warns, it tells us right from wrong (Ro 2:14-15) - not being able to be rightly accused of anything - God's will is that we at some point in time suffer for doing what is right (17) - Christ died for sins once for all (18) - The just died for the unjust - He would bring us back to God - Put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the Spirit (Ro 6) - He went to make proclamation to the spirit in prison (19) (Eph 4:8-10) - Disobedient spirits - in days of Noah (Gen 6) - 8 that were brought safely through the water (20) - II Pet 2:4-9 - Baptism now saves you - not removal of dirt from flesh - but an appeal to God for a good conscience (21) - Christ is at the right hand of God - all things being subjected to Him (22) (Co 1:15-20; 2:9-10; Eph 1:18-23)
