<p>- true believers living in obedience</p> <p>- We need to work out what God has put in to us - bring glory and pleasure to God</p> <p>Greek Word Meanings</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Voice - active, passive, middle - Mood - indicative/imperative - Tense - past, present, future, perfect <p>Fear - put into fear, terror, awesomeness, reverence, respect, wholesome caution, a healthy fear of offending God</p> <p>Trembling - shaking in fear, quaking, not trusting self but an active dependence on the Holy Spirit</p> <p>To Will - to determine, choose or prefer, to do something gladly, desire, determine with a purpose</p> <p>To work - to be active, to be efficient, fervent, mighty in</p> <p>Work out your salvation - work = do a deed, labor, toil, achieve, carry to the ultimate conclusion, carry to the goal</p>	<p>Do all things without grumbling and complaining</p> <p>Jn 6:41-43 - what Jesus said about Himself</p> <p>Matt 20:11 - fairness</p> <p>Lk 5:30 - company He keeps</p> <p>Acts 6:1 - your not meeting my needs</p> <p>Jude 16 - grumblers, find fault, following after their own lusts, speak arrogantly, flatter to gain advantage</p> <p>Korah's Rebellion - Numbers 16:41 - God's authority</p> <p>I Cor 10:1-11 - OT gives us examples to follow of what is good and bad</p> <p>SYMPTOM - heart condition that has to do with self</p>	<p>Not grumbling will prove us to be blameless, innocent, children of God above reproach</p> <p>We live in a crooked and perverse generation - world is in Satan's grasp (II Peter 3:9 - God is waiting for His time to end Satan's reign)</p> <p>Children of Lights</p> <p>John 1:4-5, 9 - darkness doesn't comprehend light, Jesus is the true light that enlightens every man</p> <p>John 3:19-21 - men love the darkness instead of light because they don't want deeds exposed</p> <p>John 8:12 - Jesus is the light of the world, we don't have to live in darkness</p> <p>John 11:9-10 - stumble in darkness, walk in the day</p> <p>John 12:35-46 - don't need to stay in darkness</p> <p>Daniel 3 - while everyone bowed, 3 men stood firm for the Lord</p> <p>Roman 12:1-2 - living and holy sacrifice - transformed and not conformed</p>

<p>Hold fast to the word of life</p> <p>I Cor 15:2 - the word saves us - hold fast to it</p> <p>Col 2:19 - need to hold fast to the head which is Christ</p> <p>I Thes 5:21 - hold fast to that which is good</p> <p>Titus 1:9 - hold fast to the faithful word - exhort in sound doctrine and refute those who contradict</p> <p>He 3:6 - hold fast to our confidence - in Christ Alone</p> <p>He 3:14 - hold fast to our assurance</p> <p>He 4:14 - hold fast to our confession</p> <p>He 10:23 - hold fast to our hope</p> <p>Rev 2:13 - holding fast to Jesus' name</p>	<p>The day of Christ</p> <p>I Cor 1:8 - confirmed as blameless in that day</p> <p>I Cor 5:5 - there is a day that people will be judged</p> <p>II Cor 1:13-14 - showing of who stood firm</p> <p>Phil 1:6-10 - we will be complete in the day of Christ Jesus - being found blameless in the day of Christ</p> <p>I John 3:1-3 - that we will see Jesus just as He is and we will be like Him</p> <p>I Thes 2:19-20 - Jesus at His coming</p> <p>I Thes 3:12-13 - blameless at the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ with His saints</p> <p>I Thes 5:23 - we will be blameless at the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ</p> <p>I Thes 5:1-10; 4:13-18</p>	<p>Run in vain, toil in vain</p> <p>Vain - without results, emptiness, fruitlessness</p> <p>Toil - hard labor, sacrificial labor</p> <p>Run - goal is to reach the end, the finish line</p> <p>Poured Out as a drink offering - Paul poured his life out for the gospel</p> <p>II Tim 4:6-8 - his life was over</p> <p>II Tim 4:17-18 - he was going to be delivered to heaven</p>	<p>God changes our heart of stone into a heart of flesh</p> <p>Put His commandments in our hearts - internal</p> <p>His Spirit would dwell in us Jeremiah 31:31-34</p> <p>Holy Spirit's job John 14:15-27 - comfort us, teach us all things John 16:13 - guides us in truth, disclose of the Father to us John 16:8 - convict us of sin Romans 8:1-17, 26-27 - leads us, testifies with our spirit that we are children of God - intercedes for us Gal 5:16-26 - give you the fruit of the Spirit - He will help you put aside the deeds of flesh Eph 1:13-14 - sealed with promise of salvation Eph 5:18 - filled by the Spirit</p> <p>Grieve - Eph 4:17-32 - Christian - by not living in the new man Quench - I Thes 5:12-22 - Christian - to put out a fire or thirst Blasphemy - Matt 12:28-32 - Non-believer -</p>
