2 1/2 Tribes -13	Caleb Gets Hebron - 14	Allotments - 15-19
<p>1-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Joshua is old, advanced in years - Areas that are still to be possessed - God promises to drive the people out - Land that was captured to the east of the river - Mt Hermon, Arnon River (Aroer) <p>15-23 - Reuben's territory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sons of Israel killed Balaam - the diviner (prophet for hire) - Killed him by the sword <p>24-28 - Gad's territory</p> <p>29-31 - 1/2 Manasseh's territory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 60 cities <p>32-33</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Levites had no inheritance among the sons - Their inheritance was the Lord (14) 	<p>1-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Eleazar the priest, Joshua, heads of the households apportioned the land - By lot as the Lord commanded for the 9 1/2 tribes - The Levites didn't get land - cities and the pasturelands - Joseph was given a double portion - Manasseh and Ephraim <p>6-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Caleb is from the tribe of Judah - Lord made a promise through Moses to Caleb - He followed the Lord fully - Num 13:21-24, 30-33; 14:5-10, 20-25, 36-38; Dt 1:34-40 - Caleb is 85 years old - Still strong - as strong as when he was 40 and sent to spy out the land - He wants to possess Hebron and is willing to drive out the Anakim <p>13-15</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Caleb was blessed for his for obedience - following the Lord fully - Land had rest from war 	<p>Judah (15)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Caleb acquiring Hebron - Othniel captures Kiriath-sepher and gets Caleb's daughter as a wife - Judges 3:9-11 - They didn't drive out the Jebusites in Jerusalem <p>Ephraim (16)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - didn't drive out the people of Gezer - Forced laborers (Dt 20:16) <p>Manasseh (17)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - daughters of Zelophehad getting an inheritance - Nu 26:33; 27:1, 7; 36:2, 6, 10-11; I Chron 7:15 - Did not drive out the Canaanites - they had chariots and were strong <p>Benjamin (18)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - tabernacle is set up in Shiloh - Between Joseph and Judah <p>Simeon</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - was in Judah (too large) <p>Zebulun</p> <p>Issachar</p> <p>Asher</p> <p>Naphtali</p> <p>Dan</p>

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Cities of Refuge - 20	48 Levite Cities - 21	2 1/2 Tribes Return - 22
<p>1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - where a manslayer can escape - unintentionally kills someone - Protected from the avenger of blood - Flee to the gate and state their case - Taken into the city and cared for - He will not be given to the avengers - Stays in the city until the death of the high priest - he can then return home 	<p>1-7</p> <p>Kohath - Aaron & priests - 13 cities from Judah, Simeon, Benjamin</p> <p>Kohath - others - Ephraim, Dan, 1/2 tribe of Manasseh - 10 cities</p> <p>Gershon - 13 cities - Asher, Naphtali, 1/2 tribe of Manasseh, Issachar</p> <p>Merari - 12 cities - Reuben, Gad, Zebulun</p> <p>8-12 - Hebron was given to Caleb</p> <p>13-40 - distribution of the cities</p> <p>41-45</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God gave them the land - it was promised and that promise was kept - Gave them rest on every side - not one of their enemies could stand - Not one of the good promised that God made to the house of Israel failed 	<p>1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they had kept the commands of the Lord and fought for their brothers (7 years) - Go take possession of your land - Warnings - be careful to observe God's commands, love God, walk in His ways, keep commandments, hold fast to Him, serve Him alone <p>7-9 - they are to divide the spoils amongst each other - departed from Shiloh</p> <p>10-34</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 1/2 tribes build an altar - Built on the side of the Jordan belonging to Israel - Israel (west) takes offense, assumes they are acting unfaithfully, and prepare for war - Pr 18:17 - didn't hear the other side - They built the altar to be a witness - a reminder that they were brother - God dwells among the people in Shiloh - Phinehas is pleased - the altar is called "Witness" - the Lord is God
