<ul> <li>He suffered in the flesh (1)</li> <li>Arm yourself with the same purpose - we can be triumphant in our suffering (Mt 10:38-39; Il Cor 4:8-11)</li> <li>He who suffers in flesh has ceased from sin - there is not effective threat (the greatest weapon of the enemy) because death has no power over us any more</li> <li>Live for the will of God not the lusts of men (2) - we should be pursuing holiness that comes through God</li> <li>We carried out the desire of the flesh (3)</li> <li>World is surprised that we aren't chasing the desires that they do (4)</li> <li>They will give an account (5) - Mt 12:36; Ro 14:11-12; He 4:13</li> <li>Gospel has been preached - they are judge in the flesh as people they may live in the spirit according to the will of God (6)</li> <li>Rom 6</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>end of all things is near (7) Dan 12:9-13; He 1:1-2; Acts 2:16-21; I Peter 1:5, 20; II Peter 3:3; I John 2:18; I Cor 15:22-24</li> <li>Be of sound judgment (7)</li> <li>Sober of spirit for the purpose of prayer - not being swept away by emotions</li> <li>Keep fervent in your love for one another (8) - requires putting another's spiritual good ahead of your own desires</li> <li>Hospitable to one another without complaint (9) - caring for the needs of others</li> <li>Using your gifts (10-11)</li> <li>if speaking - speaking the utterances of God</li> <li>If serving - you are serving in God's strength</li> <li>In all things God may be glorified</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>don't be surprised at the fiery ordeal which comes for testing (12)</li> <li>Not some strange thing - believer's testing, purging, and cleansing</li> <li>To the degree we suffer that will be the degree we can exult (13) - James 1:2</li> <li>If you are reviled for Christ you are blessed (14)</li> <li>Suffer as a Christian - not ashamed, but glorify God (16)</li> <li>Judgment begins with the household of God (17) - this isn't condemnation but a purifying of the church by the loving hand of God</li> <li>The righteous are saved with difficulty, what will become of the unrighteous? (18)</li> <li>Suffering according to the will of God - entrust their souls to faithful Creator in doing what is right (19)</li> <li>Glory and suffering</li> <li>Mt 5:10-12; Jn 15:18-22; Ro 8:16-18; II</li> <li>Tim 3:12; James 1:2-4, 12; I Peter 1:6-7; I Peter 5:1, 10</li> </ul>
