<p>if someone is caught in sin those who are spiritual are to restore them with gentleness</p> <p>restore = to mend, to repair - like a broken bone</p> <p>bear one another's burdens burdens = extra loads - difficulties, problems that people have</p> <p>bear them to fulfill the law of Christ - love (Gal 5:13-14; John 13:34-35; Romans 13:8, 10; I John 5:1-3; James 2:1-12)</p> <p>examine your life (works) first - Matt 7:1-5</p> <p>each one will bear his own load load = life's routine obligations (ministry and calling)</p>	<p>the one who receives is supposed to share with the one who teaches (I Cor 9:7-14; Philippians 4:10-19)</p> <p>Don't be deceived (7)</p> <p>Don't lose heart in doing good (9)</p> <p>Let us do good to all people (10) especially to those of the faith (John 13:35)</p>	<p>there are those trying to get people circumcised so they will have followers after themselves (12)</p> <p>trying to pull people away from the gospel to gather a group faithful to the law - brag about their effective (13)</p> <p>boasting in the cross of Christ</p> <p>the world has been crucified to me and me to the world (I John 2:15-17)</p> <p>circumcision is meaningless - we need to be a new creation (Philippians 3:2-11; new creation (II Cor 5:17; Romans 8:11-17; John 3:3)</p> <p>Israel of God - Romans 9:1-8</p>	<p>brand-marks - scars of service</p> <p>Acts 14:1-22</p> <p>II Corinthians 4:7-12; <u>11:23-30</u></p> <p>5 times he received 39 lashes</p> <p>3 times beaten with clubs</p> <p>stoned once (thought to be dead)</p> <p>shipwrecked</p>
