Lot's wife looks back - her heart was there Lot didn't want to leave - then he didn't want to go where he was told Two daughters sin by getting father drunk and lying with him 	 possession of Canaanites (10:19) Wicked exceedingly and sinners against the Lord (13:10-13) - Gen 6:5-7 Powerful, rich city (Gen 14) Sin was exceeding grave (Gen 18:20) Not even 10 righteous people in the city God goes to see the sin (18:21) - Gen 11:6-9 Evil in that city was overwhelming (19:4-11) God rained down fire and brimstone from heaven Dt 29:23; 32:32 - burning waste of 4 cities - held them as an example of the punishment of wickedness Is 3:9 - they didn't even try to conceal their wickedness - arrogance or haughtiness Jer 23:14; 50:40 - no one turns back from their evil - God will completely overthrow sin Lam 4:6 Ez 16:46-55 Matt 11:23-24 Jude 7 - indulged in gross immorality, went after strange flesh, exhibited as an example in undergoing punishment of eternal fire Rev 11:8 	 Jude 7 - gross immorality, going after strange flesh Ro 1:18-32 suppress truth in unrighteousness (18) Knew God but didn't honor Him as God (21) They were unthankful (21) Foolish hearts became darkened (21) Professing to be wise, they became fools (22) Exchanged the glory of God for image of corruptible things (23) God gives them over to their degrading passions (25) Exchanged God's truth for a lie (25) Dishonor their bodies (24) Indecent acts lead to receiving due penalty for their error (27) SIN! Abraham interceded for these people II Tim 2:24-26 - in gentleness correct those who are in opposition to God's Word - bring them to the knowledge of truth Need to love the sinner but not the sin Pray for them Tell them the truth do it gently
