God's Plan	Before the Foundation of the World	The Solution
<p>Satan took Adam and Eve's eye off of God</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- he (Satan) became their god</li> <li>- They did his bidding</li> <li>- Satan acquired the dominion of the earth</li> </ul> <p>Someone needed to rescue man from Satan's domain and transfer him the kingdom of His Son (Col 1:13-14)</p> <p>Paul uses "administration" (Eph 1:9-10)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- #G3622 - oikonomia - dispensation, stewardship</li> <li>- Management of a household or of household affairs</li> </ul> <p>God has a plan - to bring things back under His authority</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Eph 3:8-10 - it will remain a mystery until God is ready to reveal it</li> <li>- When the church began - it was God's statement to the world that He has never been out of control</li> <li>- Mt 16:18 - church is built on the knowledge that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God - the gates of Hades cannot overtake it</li> <li>- I Peter 3:18-20 - Jesus made proclamation to the spirits of who He was</li> <li>- Jesus was going to be the Redeemer</li> </ul>	<p>God knew Adam's choice - disobedience - plan of salvation would bring redemption - administrate His household</p> <p>God shared the plan (partially to Abraham)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- raise up a nation</li> <li>- From that nation would come a seed</li> <li>- World would be blessed by Him (Gen 12:3; 22:18; Gal 3:16)</li> <li>- The seed would be the woman's seed (Gen 3:15) that would crush Satan's head</li> <li>- The details of the plan were to remain a mystery until the fullness of time</li> </ul> <p>Fullness of Time (Jn 2:4; 4:21, 23; 5:25, 28; 7:30; 8:20; 12:23, 27; 13:1; 16:2, 32; 17:1)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Jesus left heaven and took on flesh and blood</li> <li>- Became the Son of Man to pay the penalty for our sins</li> <li>- Born of a virgin (I Cor 15:22, 42-49)</li> <li>- Hung on a tree and then buried</li> <li>- Raised on the 3rd day</li> <li>- He descended to make proclamation to the spirits</li> <li>- 40 days on earth - appearing to many</li> <li>- Ascended into heave to sit at the right hand of God as the Son of Man</li> <li>- Spirit of God came and sealed those adopted as His children</li> <li>- The church was started - God's plan of restoration</li> <li>- No one can thwart God's plan (I Cor 15:24)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- We are slaves - captives of Satan</li> <li>- Need to be freed</li> <li>- I can't free myself</li> <li>- Satan won't free us</li> <li>- Someone has to pay the price to purchase us out of the slave market</li> <li>- Jer 17:14 - heal me, O Lord - save me</li> <li>- Jesus will be a Kinsman Redeemer</li> <li>- Jn 8:36 - if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed</li> </ul> <p>Kinsman Redeemer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- "Go'el = a person who has the right to redeem, to purchase, buy back - blood relative or an inheritance that was lost due to death or debt</li> <li>- The implication is that the person is helpless, there needs to be a 3rd party to intervene</li> <li>- "koper" - to ransom, atone by making a substitutionary payment</li> <li>- "padar" - transfer ownership through a payment of some equivalent transaction</li> </ul> <p>Emphasis on the relationship between the redeemer and the redeemed</p>

OT Law of Redemption	Raising up Children	Ruth
<p>Lev 25:47-55</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- if someone is poor and sells himself to someone - the closest kinsman has the right and responsibility to purchase his freedom</li> <li>- In the year of jubilee (50 years) people's freedom and land are restored</li> </ul> <p>Jn 8:34-36</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- if we sin, we become slaves to sin</li> <li>- If the Son (Jesus) set you free, you will be free indeed</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- there is a great importance of land and inheritance and family lineage in Jewish culture</li> <li>- Levirate marriage - brother-in-law law</li> <li>- Protect the family line</li> <li>- Dt 25:5-10 - the brother is supposed to help establish the house of his deceased brother</li> <li>- Why the sandal? - foot represents power and possession - taking off the sandal and passing it on symbolizes transferring the right to walk on and own land</li> </ul> <p>Gen 38:2-11- condemnation for not upholding his brother's name - he was put to death</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 1:1-5 - introduction</li> <li>- 1:6-13 - Naomi tells the girls to go back to their families</li> <li>- 1:14-22 - Ruth returns with Naomi</li> <li>- 2 - Ruth gleanes in the field of Boaz (20)</li> <li>- 3:1-5 - Naomi tells Ruth what to do</li> <li>- 3:6-18 Boaz will present the case to her closest kinsman in the morning</li> <li>- 4:1-6 - the closest relative didn't want to redeem Ruth</li> <li>- 4:7-8 - removes his sandal and gives it to Boaz</li> <li>- 4:9-12 - Boaz claims his right as kinsman redeemer</li> <li>- 4:13-15 - Boaz and Ruth married</li> <li>- 4:16-22 - genealogy</li> </ul>

### 6 Qualifications of the Kinsman Redeemer

#1 - Blood Relative	#2 - Ability to Pay Price of Redemption	#3 - Desire to Redeem His Kinsman
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God would send a kinsman redeemer made of flesh and blood (Mt 1:18)</li> <li>- Born of God - by the Holy Spirit not the seed of Adam</li> <li>- Jesus - God incarnate</li> <li>- Blood relative of mankind through the woman but born of the seed of God</li> <li>- He took on flesh and blood (He 2:14-17; 4:15)</li> </ul> <p>Adam's choice did not seal our fate - God had a plan</p>	<p>NT word for redeem Lutroo - to release on receipt of ransom Exagorazo - purchasing a slave with a view to his freedom</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Lev 17:11 - it is the blood that is shed on the altar that makes atonement for our sins</li> <li>- He 10:4-10 - we have been sanctified through the offering of His body (it was the purchase price for us)</li> <li>- I Peter 1:18-19 - we were redeemed by precious blood of a lamb unblemished and spotless - the blood of Jesus Christ</li> <li>- Eph 1:7-8 - redemption through His blood - forgiveness according to the riches of His grace</li> <li>- Col 1:13-14 - He rescued us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Heb 10:4-10 - God had a plan laid out before the foundation of the world</li> <li>- Jn 15:13 - Jesus laid down His life for His friends (covenant term)</li> <li>- I Jn 3:1 - because of God's great love that He bestowed upon us - we can be called the children of God</li> </ul>

6 Qualifications of the Kinsman Redeemer

#4 - Willingness to Redeem Kinsman	#5 - Serve As Judicial Executioner of Murderer of His Relative	#6 - Responsibility and Authority to Redeem Land and Remove Squatters
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ruth 4:6 - the closest relative didn't want to redeem</li> <li>- Jesus came as the Lamb and shed His blood for our redemption</li> <li>- Garden of Gethsemane - Jesus cried out that this cup be taken from Him (Lk 22:39-46; Mt 26:36-44)</li> <li>- He 5:7-10</li> <li>- Jesus knew He would die, be buried, and rise on the 3rd day</li> <li>- Jesus was God - He never laid aside His deity (Ph 2:6-8)</li> <li>- Jesus set aside His prerogative to act as God</li> <li>- He became man and lived as man - in complete obedience and dependance on God</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Bible speaks about capital punishment (Gen 9:5-6; Ex 21:12-14; Dt 19:10-13; Num 35:15-25, 30-31, 33)</li> <li>- Man was made in the image of God (Ex 21:12-14)</li> <li>- Satan is responsible for bringing death to man - Jn 8:44 - Satan was a murderer from the beginning - he needs to be put to death when the Kinsman Redeemer meets him - Jesus will have the final word</li> <li>- I Tim 1:8-11 - the law is to be upheld - and we have a righteous Judge</li> </ul> <p>How do we live then?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ro 12:17-21 - we are not to pay back evil for evil but overcome evil with good</li> <li>- Ro 2:8-11 - God will judge sin impartially</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Lev 25:23-25 - the right and responsibility to redeem the land</li> <li>- Adam &amp; Eve had the right to rule and reign but they forfeited it to Satan (Jn 14:30; 12:31; II Cor 4:3-4)</li> <li>- Gen 3:15 - the promise of Jesus crushing Satan's head - prophecy</li> <li>- Jn 12:23-33 - His death will bring life (the crucifixion - "hour")</li> <li>- Col 2:11-15 - cancelled the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us - Jesus took this away and nailed it to the cross</li> <li>- Col 1:26-27 - Christ in you - the hope of glory</li> <li>- He 10:8-12 - Through Jesus' one sacrifice - sins were covered for all time</li> <li>- Ro 6:22-23 - freed from sin and become slaves to God - sanctification - eternal life</li> <li>- Ps 110:1; I Cor 15:25-28 - demonic forces and powers will become His footstool</li> <li>- Rev 5:1-6:1 - start breaking the 7 seals - the One who is worthy is the Lamb of God</li> <li>- Jer 32:6-15, 44</li> <li>- The breaking of the seals the beginning of the cleansing process</li> </ul>
