Melchizedek	Aaronic Priesthood	Jesus
<p>Gen 14 -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - King of Salem (Peace) (18) - priest to God Most High - he blesses Abram - Abram gives Melchizedek 1/10 of everything (20) <p>Hebrews 5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Order of Melchizedek (6) - followed in the order of Melchizedek <p>Hebrews 7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - king of righteousness (2) - without mother/father/genealogy (3) - no beginning of days or end of life - made like the Son of God - remains a priest perpetually - his priesthood didn't come from physical requirement - but according to the power of an indestructible life (16) 	<p>Hebrews 5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - appointed on behalf of men (1) - offered gifts and sacrifices - beset with weakness (2) - offers sacrifices for the people and for himself (3) - called by God (4) <p>Hebrews 7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - when the priesthood changes the Law changes as well (12) - prevented from continuing by death (23) - priests made sacrifices daily (26) 	<p>Hebrews 5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God appointed Jesus as priest (5-6) - He obeyed His Father to the death (7) - He was perfect (9) - He became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey Him <p>Hebrews 7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - He is a descendant of Judah (14) - He is a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek (17) - Jesus is the guarantee of a better covenant (22) - Holds His priesthood permanently (24) - He is able to save forever those who draw near to God (25) - He lives to always make intercession for us - He offered up the sacrifice (Himself) once for all (27)
