

## Ezekiel 33-35 - Lesson 10

Watchmen/Jerusalem's Capture - 33	Watchmen Lived Out
<p>1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the watchman has the duty to warn people about impending danger</li><li>- If he warns and people don't listen - the blood is on their hands</li><li>- If he doesn't warn then he is responsible for their blood</li></ul> <p>7-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- we are responsible for giving the message</li><li>- We are not responsible for their response</li></ul> <p>10-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- God's heart is not to punish the wicked</li><li>- He cries out for them to turn away from their wicked ways</li><li>- The righteous man can't trust in his righteousness for life</li><li>- Jer 7:3-11 - their trust was in the temple - even though they practiced abomination</li></ul> <p>17-20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- We are judged according to our ways</li></ul> <p>21-22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- after Jerusalem falls - Ezekiel can now speak to the people he is no longer mute</li><li>- 3:26-27 - tells of his muteness</li><li>- He can say thus says the Lord . . . (122 times in Ezekiel)</li><li>- 24:25-27 - tells when he will be able to speak again</li></ul> <p>23-29</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- God will make the land a desolation and they will know that He is God</li></ul> <p>30-33</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the people will hear but they will not obey</li></ul>	<p>Acts 16:24-25 - Paul and Silas sing and praise God in prison</p> <p>Acts 20:17-32 - Paul did not shrink back from declaring the gospel of grace of God</p> <p>II Cor 11:21-33 - all that Paul suffered while preaching the gospel of God - there were dangers at every turn</p> <p>I Peter 4:12-19 - expect fiery ordeals - keep on praising God - we entrust ourselves to Him</p> <p>Jn 15:18-19 - we are hated because we represent Christ and the world hated Him (Satan hates Him - hates those created in God's image)</p> <p>Phil 1:29 - we have been granted the privilege to suffer for Him</p> <p>Phil 3:10-11 - join in the fellowship of His sufferings</p> <p>II Tim 3:12 - all who desire to live godly will be persecuted</p>

Shepherds of Israel - 34	Shepherds' Warnings
<p>1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the shepherds are fleecing the flock</li></ul> <p>7-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the flock is scattered</li><li>- The shepherds are gone - they feed themselves not the flock</li><li>- The shepherds destroy the flock</li></ul> <p>11-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- God finds the scattered and cares for them</li></ul> <p>17-22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- now those who are strong are bullying those who are weaker</li><li>- Judging between the sheep and the goats (Matt 25:31-46)</li></ul> <p>23-24</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- David will shepherd the flock (picture of the last one to sit on David's throne - Jesus)</li></ul> <p>25-31</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- there will be a time that God's people, Israel will dwell in safety and in peace and will not endure insults from the nations any more</li><li>- This has not happened</li></ul>	<p>Jer 3:12-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- when God gathers His people there will be shepherds who care</li></ul> <p>Jer 10:21</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- shepherds will become stupid when they don't seek the Lord</li><li>- The flock will scatter</li></ul> <p>Jer 23:1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the millennial reign - His people will be cared for</li></ul> <p>Jer 50:6-7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- they did this to themselves - the shepherds misled and the sheep followed blindly</li></ul> <p>Mt 2:4-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Jesus will come forth and shepherd His people</li></ul> <p>Mt 26:31-33</p> <p>You strike the shepherd the sheep will scatter</p> <p>Jn 10:11-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Jesus the Good Shepherd laid down His life for the sheep</li></ul> <p>Jn 10:24-30</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- He knows sheep and the sheep know Him</li></ul> <p>He 13:20-21</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- God through the Good Shepherd equips us to do His will working in us what is pleasing to Him</li></ul>

## Ezekiel 33-35 - Lesson 10

Prophecy Against Edom - 35	Who Is Edom?
<p>They will know that He is the Lord (1-9)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- God will make Edom a desolation and a waste</li><li>- They have an everlasting hatred toward the people of Israel</li><li>- Comes against Israel with the sword</li><li>- God will give them over to bloodshed</li></ul> <p>God will bring His anger against them because of their anger and envy (10-11)</p> <p>God has heard all their reviling (12)</p> <p>They are arrogant (13)</p> <p>They rejoiced over Israel because of their desolation (14-15)</p>	<p>Gen 25:19-34 - Esau = Edom</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- the enmity started when they were born</li><li>- It continued through their life</li><li>- The nations (Edom and Israel) were enemies from Israel's inception</li></ul> <p>Ez 25:12-14 - constantly seeking revenge</p> <p>Obadiah - prophesied of their destruction</p>
