<p>Chapt 1- 3-14 - spiritual blessings coming through grace - hope is in Christ</p> <p>15-23 - hope of our calling, riches of glory/inheritance, surpassing greatness of His power</p> <p>Mentions the mystery - summing up all things in Christ</p> <p>Chapter 2 1-10 - formerly dead but now made alive in Christ 11-22 - you were formerly far off but have been brought near through the blood of Christ</p> <p>Mystery - two groups (Jew and Gentile) made into one (the church or the body) - God's household, holy temple, dwelling of God</p> <p>Chapter 3 1-13 - mystery of Christ - Gentiles as fellow heirs 14-21 - prayer - strengthened with power, Christ dwell in hearts</p> <p>Church is to be His glory</p>	<p>Eph 1:19 - surpassing greatness of God's power toward those who believe Eph 3:16 - comes through the Holy Spirit in the inner man Eph 3:20 - power works in us</p> <p>Acts 1:8 - receive the power when the Holy Spirit comes - empowers us to be God's witnesses</p> <p>Acts 3:1-12 - people wondered by what power the man was healed - power was in the name of Jesus Christ</p> <p>II Cor 12:7-10 - power is perfected in weakness, when I am weak - He is strong</p> <p>I Cor 2:4-5 - our faith should not rest on the wisdom of men but on the power of God</p> <p>I Pet 1:3-5 - I am protected by the power of God</p>	<p>Eph 3:5 - mystery was revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit</p> <p>Eph 3:6-7 - Gentiles are - fellow heirs - Fellow members of the body - Fellow partakers of the promise in Christ through the Gospel Eph 3:9-10 - the mystery was hidden in God so that the manifold wisdom of God would be made known through the church to the rulers and authorities</p> <p>Eph 3:11-12 - there is an eternal purpose - there is boldness and confident access to the Father through Jesus Christ</p>	<p>Eph 3:14-15 Every family derives its name from God the Father</p> <p>God grant (16-19) - riches of His glory - Strengthened with power through His Spirit - That we may comprehend - to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge - Be filled up to all the fullness of God</p>
