Calvary - A Place of Refuge	Prophecy of Isaiah 52:13-53:12
<p>Lord's death and resurrection is our place of refuge and healing</p> <p>At the cross we meet Jehovah-rapha - the Lord who heals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- intercedes for us- Experienced our pain- II Cor 5:21 - He was made sin for you so you might become the righteousness of God in Him- There is no wound that Calvary can't heal <p>Rapha = healed, to cure, repair thoroughly, to make whole</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Is 53:5 - by His scourging we are healed (rapha)	<p>Jesus as Servant (13)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- will be high and lifted up (crucifixion) and greatly exalted (Phil 2:9)- Was marred more than any man (14) - so horrendous that people people were astonished - beyond their belief- Grew up as a tender shoot among them (2)- Despised and rejected (3) (Jn 3:19-21 - Light that exposed their deeds)- Suffered abuse and grief by those He came to save (Mt 23:37; Lk 13:34)- Bore our griefs and sorrows (4)- Pierced for our transgression - our sin put Him there (5)- We sin and our iniquity fell on Him (6)- The people deserved the punishment that was heaped on Him (8)- God was pleased to crush Him if He would render Himself as a guilt offering (10) - He didn't deserve it but God's will for Him was to endure it- Result of His anguish was God's judgment was satisfied (11) and the Righteous One justified many
