He was not circumcised

Paul trusts Timothy to take the message himself (Acts 19:22)

Timothy was left as an example of what it means to imitate

Paul who imitates Christ (I Cor 4:14-17)

He was faithful

there is a kindred spirit (Philippians 2:19-24)

he was genuinely concerned about others

he proved his worth to Paul and others

served to further the gospel

Seems like Timothy was imprisoned for the gospel (He 13:23)
