Facts About Rest	Scriptures About	Views and Conclusions
<p>Children of Israel (3:14-19)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- provoked God</li> <li>- disobedience</li> <li>- hardened by deceitfulness of sin</li> <li>- unbelief - leads to not entering the rest</li> <li>- rejected God - no rest</li> </ul> <p>Heb 3:6, 14 - if we hold fast - then our faith is proven and we will not miss His rest</p> <p>Heb 4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- promise of entering His rest (1)</li> <li>- there is a potential to fall short of His rest (1)</li> <li>- need to hear the message - unite that with faith (2)</li> <li>- we who have believed enter that rest (3)</li> <li>- God rested on the 7th day from all His works (4)</li> <li>- even when they had the good news preached to them, they failed to enter because of disobedience (6)</li> <li>- today you need to respond (7)</li> <li>- Joshua didn't give them rest (8)</li> <li>- there is a Sabbath rest for the people of God (9)</li> <li>- to enter the rest we cease from our work (10)</li> <li>- be diligent to enter that rest (11)</li> </ul>	<p>Gen 2:1-3 - God rested after completing His creation work</p> <p>Ex 20:8-11 - God was an example to us - Israel is to work 6 days and rest the 7th</p> <p>Ex 31:12-17 - a sign between God and Israel forever - there is a refreshing trait about keeping the Sabbath</p> <p>Ez 20:8 (6-26) - they were not willing to let go of their own life (things, idols, lifestyle) - held on to the old</p> <p>Mark 2:27 - the Sabbath was made for man - not the man for the Sabbath</p> <p>We are to rest, we are to be refreshed, we are to spend time with God</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Faith-rest life - live our lives resting on the promises of God - cease from striving to please God on our own - walk by faith (Col 2:6-7; II Cor 5:7; Matt 11:28-30)</li> <li>2. The Millennial rest - when the covenant promises to Israel are completely fulfilled - then we will rest in the millennial kingdom (Dan 7:13, 14, 27; Zech 14:16-21)</li> <li>3. Eternal rest - rest in the New Heaven, the New Earth, and the New Jerusalem (Rev 14:13; Is 65:17-18; 66:22-23)</li> </ol>
