<p><b>TAKE OFF</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- malice #G2549 - malignity, ill-will, desire to injure, depravity</li> <li>- Deceit #G1388 - crafty, guile (to decoy), a lure, snare</li> <li>- Hypocrisy #G5272 - acting of a stage player</li> <li>- Envy #G5355 - jealousy, spite, feeling of displeasure by witnessing the advantage or prosperity of others</li> <li>- Slander #G2636 - evil speakings, defamation, backbiting</li> </ul> <p><b>PUT ON</b></p> <p>Long for the pure milk of the word</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- like newborn babies</li> <li>- Grow (passive, aorist) in respect to your salvation - IF you have tasted the grace of the Lord</li> </ul>	<p>Matt 16:13-20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- You are the Christ the Son of the living God</li> <li>- God revealed this to Peter</li> <li>- You are Peter (Petros - #G4074) - stone, little rock</li> <li>- Upon this Rock (Petra - #G4073) - rock, cliff, large</li> <li>- I will build my church on this Petra (big rock???)</li> <li>- The gates of Hades will not prevail over it</li> <li>- Keys to the kingdom given</li> <li>- Whatever bound on earth or loosed on earth shall have been bound/loosed in heaven</li> <li>- Mt 18:15-20 - it is addressing someone and calling sin sin</li> <li>- Jn 20:19-23 - acting on behalf of Jesus</li> <li>- Lk 10:17-20 - they have Jesus' power to accomplish His plan on earth</li> <li>- Eph 1:18-23 - all things are subjected to Christ - they are under the church's authority</li> </ul> <p>Keys - show power and authority (Is 22:22; Rev 3:7) - power to open, power to shut</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Lk 11:52 - took away the keys of knowledge</li> <li>- Rev 1:18 - keys to death and Hades</li> <li>- Rev 9:1; 20:1 - keys to the abyss</li> </ul>	<p>Jesus was the living - rejected by people, choice and precious in the sight of God (4)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- laid in Zion as a choice stone (6)</li> <li>- Precious cornerstone</li> <li>- Believe in Him - not be put to shame</li> <li>- Precious value to those who believe (7)</li> <li>- Unbelieving stumble over Him because of disobedience to the Word (8)</li> <li>- Lk 2:34 - He was appointed for the fall and rise of many - He was a sign to be opposed</li> </ul> <p>You also are living stones (5)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- being built up as a spiritual house</li> <li>- Holy priesthood to offer up spiritual sacrifices</li> </ul> <p>Eph 2:11-22 (19-22)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- fellow citizens in God's household</li> <li>- Foundation of apostles and prophets</li> <li>- Cornerstone - Jesus</li> <li>- We are being fitted together - growing into the holy temple of the Lord</li> <li>- Into a dwelling of God in the Spirit</li> </ul> <p>I Cor 3:16-17 - temple of God - Spirit dwells in you - you are holy</p> <p>I Cor 6:19-20 - temple of the Holy Spirit - we are not our own - bought with a price - glorify God with our body</p> <p>I Tim 3:15 - church is the household of God - the pillar and support of the truth</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Chosen race</li> <li>- Royal priesthood</li> <li>- Holy nation</li> <li>- People of God' own possession</li> <li>- Proclaim His excellencies - He called us out of darkness into light</li> <li>- Once we were not a people and didn't receive mercy (10)</li> <li>- Now we are God's people and have received mercy</li> </ul> <p>As Foreigners and Strangers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- abstain from fleshly lusts - wage war with our soul (11)</li> <li>- Keep our behavior excellent among the Gentiles (12)</li> <li>- Because of our good deeds - they glorify God</li> </ul> <p>Acting as Priesthood</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ro 12:1-2 - living sacrifice</li> <li>- Ro 15:15-16 - priest of the gospel of God</li> <li>- Rev 1:5-6 (Rev 5:9-10; 20:6) - made into a kingdom of priests</li> </ul> <p>Offering up Sacrifices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ps 50:14 (107:22) - thanksgiving</li> <li>- Ps 51:17 - broken spirit and contrite heart</li> <li>- Phil 4:17-19 - our giving an acceptable sacrifice pleasing to God</li> <li>- He 13:15-16 - fruit of our lips - praising His name - doing good and sharing</li> </ul>	<p>Hupotasso #G5293 - voluntarily place oneself under, obey</p> <p>Submit to what</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- us under human authority (I Peter 2:13; Ro 13:1-7; Titus 3:1)</li> <li>- Servants to masters (I Peter 2:18; Titus 2:9; Eph 6:5; Col 3:22)</li> <li>- Wives under husbands (I Peter 3:1; Eph 5:22; Col 3:18)</li> <li>- Younger men under older men (I Peter 5:5)</li> <li>- Believers under other believers (I Cor 16:15-16)</li> <li>- Church under Christ (Eph 5:24)</li> <li>- Christ under God (Phil 2:5-11)</li> <li>- Younger women under older women (Titus 2:4-5)</li> <li>- Ourselves under God (He 12:9; James 4:7)</li> <li>- Children under parents (Eph 6:1; Col 3:20)</li> </ul> <p>Submit to authority (13-17)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- for the Lord's sake</li> <li>- Will of God</li> <li>- Silence the ignorance of foolish men</li> <li>- Act as free people - bondservants of God</li> </ul> <p>Masters (18-20)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- submit with all respect</li> <li>- Submit to those who are good and gentle</li> <li>- Also to the unreasonable (harsh, froward) - #G4646 - crooked, perverse, wicked, unfair, surly, tyrannical, unjust</li> <li>- Finds favor with God when we bear up under suffering unjustly</li> </ul>	<p>Example = under writing, to trace or copy Hupogrammos #G5261</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- call for this purpose - follow His suffering (follow His example) (21)</li> </ul> <p>Jesus' Example</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- be holy</li> <li>- No deceit in His mouth (22)</li> <li>- When abusive insults given - don't insult in return (23)</li> <li>- When suffering - utter no threats</li> <li>- Entrust ourselves to the Righteous Judge</li> <li>- Die to sin, live to righteousness (24)</li> <li>- Were straying like sheep but now returned to thee Guardian and Shepherd of our souls (25)</li> </ul>
