Bildad's Accusations (8)	Purpose of Suffering
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - you are full of wind (2) - God doesn't pervert justice (3) - Sons sinned - God took them (4) - If you would seek God and walk rightly - God will restore you (5-7) - Learn from the past generations (8-10) - You have forgotten God (11-19) - God doesn't reject a man with integrity and he won't help evil-doers (20-22) 	<p>Ro 8:16-18 - we suffer so we can be glorified with Him</p> <p>Col 1:24 - suffering helps others</p> <p>II Thes 1:3-8 - builds perseverance and faith, we are considered worthy of the Kingdom of God</p> <p>James 1:2-4 - endurance, completeness, lacking for nothing</p> <p>I Peter 2:18-23 - we find favor with God for suffering patiently for doing what is right, Christ suffered and calls us to follow that example</p> <p>I Peter 3:14-17 - blessing, sanctification, shows the world the hope that is in us</p> <p>I Peter 4:1-2 - causes us to cease from sin and walk in the will of God</p> <p>I Peter 4:13-19 - rejoicing, blessing, glory, builds our trust in our Creator</p> <p>I Peter 5:8-10 - perfect, confirm, strengthen, establish you</p>

Job's Rebuttal (9)	Job's Cry to God (10)
<p>God is wise, powerful, holy (2-10)</p> <p>No one can restrain Him or question Him about His ways (11-12)</p> <p>God's anger seems to be against me (13-18)</p> <p>God is powerful and God is just (19)</p> <p>There is no justice for me (20-24)</p> <p>God treats the guiltless and the wicked the same - this is unfair (22)</p> <p>It seems hopeless (25-35)</p>	<p>Job is disgusted with his life and speaks out of the bitterness of his soul (1)</p> <p>Let me know why You are contending with me (2)</p> <p>Is it right to oppress and reject the work of Your hands (3) Potter & Clay - Is 29:16; 64:8; Jer 18:1-9; Ro 9:14-24</p> <p>Accusing God of seeing things mortally (4-7)</p> <p>Acknowledges that God's control over life (8-12)</p> <p>Has this been Your plan from the beginning? (13-17)</p> <p>Why was I born? (18-19)</p> <p>If this is my end - can You give me some breathing room (20-22)</p>
