<p>2:14-17 - made like His brethren in all things</p> <p>Luke 1:26-35 - Conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of a woman</p> <p>Luke 2:21-24 - lived under the law</p> <p>Luke 2:51-52 - subject to His parents</p> <p>Matt 13:55-56 - He had brothers and sisters</p> <p>Matt 4:1-11 - tempted in all things</p> <p>John 1:10-11 - Knew rejection</p> <p>John 7:2-7 - not believed in</p> <p>Is 53:2-3 - He had no stately form or majesty, no appearance that we should be attracted to Him - man of sorrows and a man of grief - He was despised</p> <p>Mark 3:21-22 - misunderstood for what He was doing</p> <p>Matt 26:36-39 - struggled in prayer with agony - but He submitted to the will of God</p> <p>Phil 2:5-11 Jesus emptied Himself took the form of a bondservant obedient even to death on a cross</p>	<p>Jesus tasted death for everyone - He 2:9 substitutionary death for me propitiation for the sins of the people (satisfaction of a debt)</p> <p>Rom 3:25 - Our sins were covered through Christ's blood</p> <p>John 1:29 - Lamb of God</p> <p>I Cor 5:7 - Our Passover</p> <p>I Peter 1:18-19 - redeemed by the blood of Christ</p> <p>II Cor 5:21 - He became sin on our behalf so we could take on His righteousness</p> <p>Gal 3:13 - Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law</p> <p>He 2:14 - Destroyed Satan's power of death</p> <p>Rev 13:8 - The Lamb was slain from the foundation of the world</p> <p>Ps 22:1-21 Ps 22:22-31</p> <p>Matt 25:34 - there was a kingdom for believers prepared before the foundation of the world</p>	<p>He 2:15 - He delivered from the fear of death - we can know what lies before us</p> <p>Ro 8:1 - there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ</p> <p>Ro 8:11 - His Spirit will give us life</p> <p>Ro 8:38-39 - Nothing can separate us from the love of God</p> <p>Ro 6:4-10 - united in Christ's death then we are united in His resurrection</p> <p>Gal 2:20 - crucified with Christ - now Christ lives in me</p> <p>II Cor 5:1-8 - death means that we will be at home with the Lord</p> <p>I Cor 15:51-58 - we will be changed and death will no longer have its sting</p> <p>I Thes 4:13-18 - we will always be with the Lord</p> <p>John 11:25-26 - believers will never die</p> <p>How do we know that we have a true faith?</p> <p>stand firm until the end!</p>
