II Thes 1:11	- Pray always	- counted worthy of your calling - fulfill every desire for goodness - the work of faith with power	- His name will be glorified in you - You'll be glorified in Him	
II Thes 3:1		- that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified - we will be rescued from perverse and evil men		- Lord is faithful - He will strengthen and protect you from the evil <i>one</i> .
I Thes 1:2	- always for all of you	- thankful for their . . . - work of faith - labor of love - steadfastness of hope		
I Thes 3:10	- night and day keep praying most earnestly - joy - rejoicing before our God on your account	- we may see your face - complete what is lacking in your faith - Rejoicing that they are standing firm		
I Thes 5:17, 25	- Pray without ceasing	- God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely - spirit/soul/body be preserved complete, blameless - Pray for us who are ministering among you		- Faithful is He who calls you - He will bring it to pass.
I Tim 2:1-4	- entreaties <i>and</i> prayers, petitions <i>and</i> thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men	- kings and for all in authority - lead a tranquil and quiet life - all godliness and dignity	- good and acceptable in the sight of God

Eph 3:14-21	- bowing the knee before the Father	- strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man - Christ may dwell in you hearts through faith - Comprehend and know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge - Filled up to fulness of God		- riches of His glory
Phil 1:3-4, 9-11	- offering prayer with joy	- praise for their participation in the gospel - Love may abound still more in knowledge and discernment - Approve the things that are excellent - Be blameless until the day of Christ	- Filled with the fruit of righteousness - To the glory and praise of God	- The One who began a good work in you and will perfect it until the day of Christ
II Tim 1:3-4	- serving God with a clear conscience - Constantly - With longing - Recalling that person	- to be able to see them - To be filled with joy
