<p>Phil 3:4-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a Jew through and through - Pharisee who kept the Law - found blameless in the Law - zealous persecutor of the church <p>Acts 7:54 - 8:3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - saw the stoning of Stephen - was for this persecution - hearty agreement with this violence - ravaging the churches - dragging believers out of their homes to prison <p>I Timothy 1:12-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - blasphemer - persecutor - violent aggressor - acted ignorantly in unbelief - the foremost of all sinners 	<p>Acts 9:1-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - road to Damascus to persecute the church - he met Jesus (Jesus came looking for him) - why was he persecuting Jesus? - taken to Damascus for 3 days he didn't eat or drink until Ananias came and laid hands on him - he is a chosen instrument to bear Jesus' name before the Gentiles, kings, and the sons of Israel - baptized - Saul becomes Paul <p>Acts 21:37-22:22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God sent Paul to the Gentiles because he would not be accepted in Jerusalem - was imprisoning and beating people but he was preaching the Word of God <p>Acts 26:1-20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Paul's message - open their eyes turn from darkness to light - turn from dominion of Satan to God - receive forgiveness of sins and inheritance - REPENT 	<p>Galatians 1:15-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God choose the time to reveal His Son to Paul - God had a purpose for Paul since before He was born - his job was to preach Christ among the Gentiles

<p>Galatians 1:6-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - different gospel is not really a gospel - distorted gospel of Christ - true gospel - not according to man but through revelation of Jesus Christ <p>I Cor 15:1-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - gospel is to be received, to be stood in, it has power to save - Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures - He was buried - He rose the 3rd day according to the Scripture - He was seen <p>Romans 1:1-5, 15-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - gospel was promised beforehand through prophets and Scripture - concerns Jesus Christ - descendant of David - Jesus is the Son of God - received grace through Christ - obedience of faith - power of God for salvation - salvation is for everyone who believes - it is the righteousness of God - revealed by faith 	<p>Romans 1:1-5, 15-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - obedience of faith - righteous shall live by faith <p>Galatians 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - faith is to preached <p>Titus 2:11-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - deny ungodliness and worldly desires - live soberly (sensibly) - righteous and godly - looking for the blessed hope - zealous for good deeds <p>Ephesians 2:10; 5:8-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - walk in the good works that God prepared for us - walk as children of light - goodness, righteousness, and truth <p>Acts 26:20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - performing deeds appropriate to repentance <p>Matt 3:8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bear fruit in keeping with repentance <p>II Cor 7:9-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sorrow that leads to repentance that leads to salvation <p>Galatians 5:18-25</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - fruit of the Spirit - not deeds of the flesh 	<p>comes from God/Jesus (1:3)</p> <p>God's grace that calls us (1:6, 15)</p> <p>calling came before we were born (1:15)</p> <p>John 1:16-17 - we received Christ's fullness through grace, grace and truth realized through Jesus Christ</p> <p>I Cor 15:1-11 - grace of God makes who I am</p> <p>Eph 1:1-8; 2:4-10 - God freely bestowed us with grace through Jesus, riches of His grace, by grace we have been saved, riches that will come in the ages to come</p> <p>Titus 2:11-14 - God's grace was made manifest in Jesus</p>
