Matt 13:3-9; 18-23 - some fell by the road and the birds snatched up - the evil one snatches away the message - Rocky soil - springs up quickly, but scorched by sun because it has no root - receives the word in joy but as soon as hardship comes - he withers away - no root - Thorns which choke it out - worry of the world and deceitfulness of wealth choke it out and it is unfruitful - Good soil produces fruit - hears the word, understands it, produces fruit  Luke 13:24-28 - strive to enter through the narrow door - many will seek to enter and will not be able - they knock, they think they should be able to enter - told to depart - He does not know them  Mt 7:13-14 - wide gate leads to destruction - many are on that - few find the narrow gate that leads to life  Mt 7:21-23 - Many will say Lord, Lord and He will tell them to depart - He never knew them  Lord = Master  Many are deceived - Most who call themselves Christians are not going to heaven!
