<p>God is the Almighty</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - He is too lofty to be concerned about you (2-4) <p>Scathing accusation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - wickedness is great (5) - Seized pledges without cause (6) - Strip men naked - No water to the weary or food to the hungry (7) - Sent widows away empty and crushed the orphans (9) <p>This is why you suffer (10-11)</p> <p>You don't think that God can see you (12-14)</p> <p>Wicked die young and the righteous are rewarded (15-20)</p> <p>Repent - you will receive your life back - you will be restored (21-30)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - complaining that His hand is heavy upon him (2) - Job wants to find God and present his case before Him (3-4) - He wants to hear God's ruling on his case (5) - God would hear him - Righteous Judge (6-7) - He couldn't sense God's presence (8-9) - He knows that God sees (10) - He seems to know that God is putting him to the test and he will come out as gold - he has stayed the course - he has remained faithful (10-12) - He has trusted a sovereign God even when he doesn't understand why things go so badly (13-17) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - knows that God has appointed time to deal with the wicked - why doesn't He share it with us (1) - Removing landmarks (Dt 19:14; Pr 22:28; 23:10) - they mistreating and stealing specifically those who can't defend themselves (2) - Mistreat widows, orphans, poor, and the needy (3-11) - Human courts would prosecute these people - why isn't God (12) - There are those who rebel against the light - they seem to get away with it (13-17) - According to their arguments - these people should be suffering but they are not (18-21) - A day of retribution is coming - God will drag them off - in His timing - His way - and the wrongs will be made right (22-24) - CONFIDENT that his point could not be refuted (25) <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Job 25</u></p> <p>Bildad has no words - God is righteous and powerful - How can man stand before Him</p>
