<p>God created man</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - out of dust of the ground (clay) - We are God's workmanship - We are the clay formed by His hands (Is 64:8) - God breathed life into man - Man became a living being - I Cor 15:45 - God's filling man with breath is a picture of the spirit of man - separate us from the animals - Ps 139:13-18 - preciousness of man to God - man is made from dirt - Our value is not in our earthly tents - but the Spirit that inhabits these tents (II Cor 5:1-10) - Job 33:4 - quality of life is the soul or spirit of man 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God planted a garden - Toward the east - area of Middle East - Babylon - In Eden - beautiful, lush place - Placed man in this garden - Unlike anything we can imagine today - Place of fellowship between God's created man and Himself 	<p>Every tree was place there to be pleasing to the sight, good for food</p> <p>tree of life</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - midst of the garden - Brought life - Man could eat of it and live forever (3:22-24) - Rev 2:7; 22:1-2, 14, 19 <p>Tree of the knowledge of good and evil</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - everything God made was good - The only thing man could gain was the knowledge of evil <p>Midst - constant reminder of God's care and God's command for obedience</p>

<p>Pishon - flows around the land of Havilah - Gold is good - Bdelium and onyx stones</p> <p>Gihon - surrounds the land of Cush</p> <p>Tigris - flows east of Assyria</p> <p>Euphrates</p> <p>Flood changed the real estate Oil comes from organic matter compressed with lots of pressure and lots heat - assumption is that the Garden was in the Middle East</p>	<p>God placed man in the garden</p> <p>Man's job - cultivate and keep the garden</p> <p>Man had a job from the very beginning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Purpose - Gives man dignity - Being a part of a team - Being obedient to God - His representative on the earth <p>Work gives satisfaction</p> <p>God gives a command</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - don't eat from this one tree - You will die - Death = separation - Physical - body and spirit - Spiritual death - separation between God and man <p>Man needed to choose - free will - is he going to follow God or live for self (Satan's)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - not good for man to be alone - God formed the beasts out of the ground - Man named all the beasts and birds - There was not a suitable helper (not corresponding to man) - God caused deep sleep - Took a rib, closed the side up (healing) - Fashioned a woman - completes him - Woman is part of the man - not less than the man - Man leaves his old family to begin a new family - this becomes man's primary responsibility - Cleave - glue together or cement together - indissoluble unit
