- God chose us in Christ before the foundation of the world that we should be holy and blameless (1:4)
- We have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace (1:7)
- God's kind intention which He purposed in Christ (1:9)
- Fullness of the times - summing up of all things in Christ - things in heavens and things on earth (1:10)

- In Christ we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses according to the riches of His grace
- All things are summed up in Christ (1:10)

- Our hope is in Christ (1:12)
- Christ was raised from the dead and seated at the right hand of God in the heavenly places - far above all rule and authority (1:20)
- Even when we were dead in our sins we were made alive together with Christ - by grace you have been saved (2:5)
- We have been raised up with Christ and seated with Him in heavenly places (2:6)
- We were created in Christ for good works (2:10)

- The mystery of Christ has been revealed that we are fellow heirs and partakers of the promise in Christ through the gospel (3:5)
- Strengthened with power through the Holy Spirit in the inner man (3:16)
- We preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (4:3)
- There is one body and one Spirit (4:4)
- Don't grieve the Holy Spirit whom you were sealed for the day of redemption (4:30)

- Christ was raised from the dead and seated Christ at His right hand in the heavenly places far above all rule and authority and power and dominion and every name named (1:21)
- Formerly walked according to the course of this world and the prince of the power of the air (2:2)
- God's grace was given to me according to the working of His power (3:7)
- We are strengthened with power through the Holy Spirit (3:16)
- Our struggle is not against flesh and blood but abasing the rulers, abasing powers, abasing world forces of this darkness (6:12)

## In Him/Christ and Other Key Words

### **According to**

- we have been adopted through Christ according to the kind intention of God's will (1:5)
- We have forgiveness of our sins according to the riches of His grace (1:7)
- God has made known to us His will according to His kind intention which He purposed in Christ (1:9)
- We have an inheritance for us according to God's purpose, working all things after the counsel of His will that through our hope in Christ we would be the praise of His glory (1:11)
- We were dead formerly walked according to the course of this world and the prince of the power of the air - but God rich in mercy and the great love with which He loves us - even those were dead in our sins, made us alive together with Christ and raised us up with Him and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus (2:2-6)
- We are partakes of the promise( in Christ Jesus according to the gift of God's grace which was given according to the working of His power (3:6-7)
- He would grant you to be strengthened with power through the Holy Spirit in the inner man, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith according to the riches of His glory (3:16-17)
- He is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think according to the power that works within us (3:20)

- Our inheritance with a view to the redemption of God's own possession to the praise of His glory (1:14)
- God is the Father of glory (1:17)
- Great riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints (1:18)
- Don't lose heart at my tribulations on your behalf for they are your glory (3:13)
- He would grant you according to the riches of His glory (3:16)
- To Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations (3:21)
- Jesus will present to Himself the church in all her glory (5:27)
