<p>1-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Samuel is grieved over Saul's rejection - He is to prepare to go anoint the king that God has chosen for Himself - He fears that Saul may kill him - Go to Bethlehem and take a sacrifice - invite Jesse and his family <p>6-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - man looks to the outward appearance - God looks at the heart - One son is out tending the sheep - Go get him - the others have been rejected <p>12-13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - anointing of David among his brothers - He is handsome in appearance - Spirit of the Lord came upon him mightily <p>14-23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David is brought to Saul's court - He would play music for Saul when he was tormented by an evil spirit 	<p>1-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - champion = a man between two - Hand to hand combat - Goliath - 6 cubits and a span - 117" = 9' 9" - Armor was 5,000 shekels = 125 pounds - Head of his spear - 600 shekels = 15 lbs <p>12-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David is sent to his brothers on the battle - He took food and inquired how things were going <p>20-30</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David wants to know why no one is fighting - Older brother chastises David <p>31-58</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David kills Goliath - not with weapons but with the power of God - The people will know that He is God - David used a sling and a stone - Israel chased and plundered the Philistines 	<p>1-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jonathan loved David - loyalty and devotion - Saul is going to keep David in his house - There was a promise of a wife and wealth to the killer of Goliath - David (II Sam 21:18-22) - Covenant is made between Jonathan and David - exchanged robe, belt, armor (II Cor 5:21) <p>6-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - song exalting David infuriated Saul and his suspicions grow <p>10-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - evil spirit torments Saul - God protects David from a deranged Saul (Ro 1:18-ff) - Saul assigns him to 1,000 men in the army - The people love David - Saul gives his daughter to someone else - Adriel (II Sam 21:8; Josh 9:20) <p>20-29</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Michal is given to David as a wife - He brought 200 foreskins as a dowry - Saul was David's enemy continually
