<p>Eph can be broken up into 3 parts</p> <p>Sit - chap 1-3 - heavenlies</p> <p>Walk - 4:6-9 - walk worthy</p> <p>Stand - 6:10-20 - stand firm</p> <p>Eph 2:1-3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- dead in our sins</li> <li>- Formerly walked</li> <li>- Walked according to the devil</li> <li>- Lived in the lusts of the flesh and the desires of the mind</li> <li>- By nature children of wrath</li> </ul> <p>Gen 1-11 - many people in the church deny the accuracy of these chapters</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- creation - Creator - has authority</li> <li>- Sin - defined - disobedience</li> <li>- Judgment on sin</li> </ul>	<p>Day 6 God spoke man into existence (26-28)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- man is made in God's image (26)</li> <li>- Rule over all the critters</li> <li>- Rule over the earth</li> <li>- Rule = H7287 - rada - dominate, tread down, subjugate, prevail against, reign, rule over or take over</li> <li>- Created man in His own image (27)</li> <li>- Made them male and female</li> <li>- God blessed them - fill the earth (28)</li> <li>- Subdue the earth</li> <li>- Subdue = H3533 - kabas = bring into subjections, bring into bondage, keep under, make subservient, tread down</li> <li>- Rule over every living thing that creeps</li> <li>- Gen 1:31 - all that God made was very good</li> </ul>	<p>7-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God formed man from dust</li> <li>- God breathed into him the breath of life</li> <li>- Planted a garden and placed man there</li> <li>- Caused every tree to grow - pleasing to the sight and good for food</li> <li>- Tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil</li> </ul> <p>Gen 2:16-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God commanded Adam - from any tree he could eat except the tree of knowledge of good and evil</li> <li>- In the day you eat you will die</li> <li>- Gen 2:18-24 - creation of Eve</li> </ul>	<p>3:1-7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- the serpent was more crafty (1)</li> <li>- Headship (I Cor 11:3) - God - Christ - man - woman</li> <li>- I Tim 2:14 - woman was deceived - man was not</li> <li>- Satan questions God's command - he makes Eve think and he has her hooked</li> <li>-</li> </ul>
