



Atonement - What Does It Mean? - Lesson 19

<div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p style="text-align: center;">enter through the door by way of Christ's sacrifice washed by His Word enter the Holy Place enter through veil - His body Come into God</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Ex 25:10-22 poles are to carry Cherubim - wings are spread faces are down looking at mercy seat I Sam 4:4 Lord sits above the cherubim</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Heb 9:5 - Cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat</p> <p style="text-align: center;">I Sam 4 - the ark was taken - "Ichabod" the glory has departed</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Heb 1:3 - Jesus is the radiance of God's glory - exact representation of God's nature</p> <p style="text-align: center;">John 1:1-2, 14 - The Word dwelt (tabernacled) among us</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p>Busyness of the Holy Place</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - daily activity - courtyard, Holy Place - Lev 24:1-9 - constant care of the lamp stand, caring for the bread - Ex 30:1-10 (6-8) - constantly burning altar of incense <p>altar can also be translated as censer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Heb 9:6-10 - gifts and sacrifices are offered that can't make the worshipper perfect - only relate to food, drink, washings - regulations imposed until a time of reformation 	<p>Yom Kippur - Leviticus 16</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. get the animals for Aaron - bull for a sin offering, ram for the burnt offering (3) for the people - 2 male goats - one for sin offering, other scape goat, ram for the burnt offering (5) 2. bathe body (washing in the water) (4) 3. put on holy clothes (4) 4. offer the bull for his sin (6, 11) 5. firepan (censer) with the blood behind the veil and sprinkle blood 7 times (12-14) 6. cast lots for the scape goat and sin offering (8) 7. kill the goat for sin offering (9) 8. the blood is taken behind the veil and sprinkled for the people (15) 9. make atonement for the holy place (16-17) 10. make atonement for the altar (18-19) 11. lay hands on scapegoat - confesses the sins of Israel and send it into the wilderness (21-22) 12. takes off holy clothes and leaves them there (23) 13. bathes again (24) 14. offer up the fat of his burnt offering for himself and then the people (25) 15. the one who released goat has to wash himself and his clothes (26) 16. animals of the sin offering are taken outside the camp and burned (27) 17. the people who burned sin offering have to wash body and clothes (28)
