<p>1-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - change of command - Moses to Joshua - Be strong and courageous - God is going before them <p>9-13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses writes these laws and gives them to the sons of Levi - Every 7 years, they are to be read to everyone at the Feast of Booths - They were to hear and learn to fear the Lord <p>14-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses will die, they will go into the land - They will forsake God and serve the gods of the land - His anger will burn and He will hide His face from them <p>19-22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses is to write a song - It is a reminder of what the people did after God took care of them <p>23 - God commissioned Joshua</p> <p>24-30</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - this book was to be beside the ark - It was a witness against them 	<p>1-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - call to pay attention - Starts by honoring God - God is their rock - strength, durable, stable, permanent (Mt 7:24-27) - They are a perverse and crooked generation - contrasted against the Rock (Mt 17:17; Phil 2:15) - He is their Father - remember how He has protected you <p>15-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jeshurun - "upright one" - #H3484 - Live up to your name! - Instead of thankfulness they became rebellious - Idol worship = demon worship <p>19-22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God turned away from them - Those who are not a nation/foolish nation (Gentile nations) - God will use to make His people jealous (Ro 11) <p>23-33</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - enemies will come in war - They assumed that God would keep on protecting them no matter what <p>34-43</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God will remember His enemies - Why can't your new gods protect you - I Am He - there is no other God - God will atone for His people <p>44-52</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - These words are their life - Observe all that God commands - Moses is called to Mt Nebo 	<p>1-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses is referred to as a man of God - Holy ones? = referring to God's angels (Acts 7:53; Gal 3:19; He 2:2) <p>6 - Reuben - life and large numbers</p> <p>7 - Judah - power and God's victories</p> <p>8-11 - Levi - fulfill their tasks before the Lord - teach and know the laws of Israel</p> <p>12 - Benjamin - security and peace</p> <p>13-17 - Joseph - was to be blessed materially - military might (Gen 48:20)</p> <p>18-19 - Zebulun/ Issachar - blessed life</p> <p>20-21 - Gad - large territory, victory in battle</p> <p>22 - Dan - energy/ strength</p> <p>23 - Naphtali - full blessing - Galilee</p> <p>24-28 - Asher - abundant fertility, prosperity</p> <p>28-29 - blessing over all of Israel</p>	<p>1-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses died in Moab - Buried in the valley opposite Beth-peor - No man knows his burial - God buried Moses - If people knew where Moses's body was buried, they would make it a place of worship - Jude 8-9 <p>9-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Joshua takes over - Sons of Israel listens to him as they did Moses - No prophet was ever like Moses - Lord knew him face to face - Signs and wonders in Egypt - Mighty power and great terror that Moses performed in Israel's sight
