Calvary - A Place of Refuge	Prophecy of Isaiah 52:13-53:12
<p>Lord's death and resurrection is our place of refuge and healing</p> <p>At the cross we meet Jehovah-rapha - the Lord who heals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- intercedes for us- Experienced our pain- II Cor 5:21 - He was made sin for you so you might become the righteousness of God in Him- There is no wound that Calvary can't heal <p>Rapha = healed, to cure, repair thoroughly, to make whole</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Is 53:5 - by His scourging we are healed (rapha)	<p>Jesus as Servant (13)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- will be high and lifted up (crucifixion) and greatly exalted (Phil 2:9)- Was marred more than any man (14) - so horrendous that people people were astonished - beyond their belief- Grew up as a tender shoot among them (2)- Despised and rejected (3) (Jn 3:19-21 - Light that exposed their deeds)- Suffered abuse and grief by those He came to save (Mt 23:37; Lk 13:34)- Bore our griefs and sorrows (4)- Pierced for our transgression - our sin put Him there (5)- We sin and our iniquity fell on Him (6)- The people deserved the punishment that was heaped on Him (8)- God was pleased to crush Him if He would render Himself as a guilt offering (10) - He didn't deserve it but God's will for Him was to endure it- Result of His anguish was God's judgment was satisfied (11) and the Righteous One justified many

Jesus Healed Through His Life	Jesus Healed Through His Death
<p>Is 53:4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - our griefs He bore - We esteemed Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted - He wasn't punished for His sins, He was punished for ours <p>Mt 8:5-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - healing of the centurion's servant (5-13) - his faith was placed in Jesus - Peter's mother-in-law, others who were sick and demon possessed (14-17) - Had the power to take away things that afflicted the people (their griefs and sorrows) 	<p>Wounds are rooted in sin Choose to walk independently of God's Word We choose not to listen, believe, or obey</p> <p>Sin mars our lives - destroys us (if we let it)</p> <p>Is 53:5 - by His scourging we are healed</p> <p>I Pe 2:24-25</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - He bore our sins in His body - We can die to sin and live to righteousness - We were straying like sheep - We have returned (repented) to the Shepherd and Guardian of our souls <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - cross was God's means of healing your sins - Sin wounds - cross heals - Now we can live righteously - what God calls right - You can live without bitterness and hatred - You can be free from sins scars, destruction, distortions - You can be whole - you can be healed <p>Psalm 22</p>

What His Death Brought Us	Jesus Heals Through His Intercession
<p>Col 2:6-15</p> <p>IN HIM</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - walk in Him (6) - Firmly rooted and built up in Him - established in faith (7) - In Him all the fullness of deity dwells (9) - Jn 1:1 - In Him you have been made complete (10) - In Him you have been circumcised in the flesh (11) - sin has been cut away from your heart <p>WITH HIM</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - buried with Him in baptism (12) - Raised with Him through faith in the working of God (12) - Made alive with Him being forgiven of our transgressions cancelling our certificate of debt (13-14) <p>THROUGH HIM</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - He triumphs over all rulers and authorities in this world (15) <p>The old man in our life has been buried We have been raised up in newness of life (Ro 6:4)</p>	<p>Truths we need to stand in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus' work for our salvation is finished - Seated at the right hand of God - interceding for us - This is His job right now - He puts His words in our mouths, He will pray for us - put words to our hurts, He gives us strength to go on - I AM NEVER ALONE (He 7:25) - It is finished - on the cross - sin was dealt with - came as a Lamb - He took away the sin of the world - Sat down at the right hand of God (He 1:3) - He intercedes for all believers (He 7:24-25) - Soon He will stand up - take the book and break the seals - He will come like a lion (Rev 5:5-7) <p>He 7:24-25</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Holds His priesthood permanently - Save those who draw near to Him (He 4:14-16) - Lives to make intercession for me <p>Standing in His Word</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - II Tim 3:16-17 - II Pe 1:20-21 - Lk 24:25-27 - Is 8:20 - Jn 17:17 - Jn 6:3
