

## Lesson 3 - Chapter 2

Overview of 1	2:1-10
<p>1:6-9 - they are quickly deserting the true gospel</p> <p>1:10-17 - bondservant of Christ preach the gospel to the Gentiles before he was born, he was chosen he was preaching what was revealed by Christ - not by men</p> <p>1:18-20 - 3 years later goes to Jerusalem to meet with Peter, James the Lord's brother</p> <p>1:21 - went to Syria and Cilicia</p> <p>2:1 - after 14 years he goes back to Jerusalem with Barnabas and Titus</p>	<p>Paul's concern was that the council would hold to the convictions of the true gospel - so he wasn't running in vain (1-2)</p> <p>Judaizers - circumcised, obey the Law (Gen 17:9-14) justification by works</p> <p>Titus came to salvation through faith (3)</p> <p>the Judaizers want to get rid of the liberty and put people into slavery (4)</p> <p>true gospel - saved by grace not works (5)</p> <p>God empowered the work of both Peter and Paul (6-8)</p> <p>Paul was blessed by the heads of the church (9-10)</p>

2:11-14	2:15-21
<p>hypocrisy - two-faced</p> <p>Peter comes to Antioch</p> <p>eating with Gentiles, fellowshiping with them</p> <p>men came - Jews</p> <p>Peter pulls away from the Gentiles</p> <p>Peter was aloof - better than them (Gentiles)</p> <p>Peer pressure - caused Peter to buckle under</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- what does God's Word say - what's the truth</li> <li>- are we here to please men or to please God</li> </ul> <p>the rest joined in with Peter including Barnabas</p> <p>Paul points back to the gospel - go back to the cross - Jesus's works on our behalf are what saves</p>	<p>Justification - to be declared righteous</p> <p>justified by faith in Christ</p> <p>not justified by flesh, works, works of the Law</p> <p>if we can have righteousness through anything we do on our own then Christ died needlessly!</p> <p>Matt 12:37 - by your words you will be justified or condemned</p> <p>Romans 3:19-20 - Law doesn't justify it shows sin</p> <p>24-26 - God is the justifier of those who have faith in Jesus</p> <p>28-30 - faith is the only means of justification</p> <p>James 2:21-25 - justification by works?????</p> <p>cf James 2:18-21</p>
