<p>leading - #G4291 - prolistemi - to stand before in rank, to preside, maintain, or be over</p> <p>diligence - #G4710 - sponde - speed, eagerness, earnestness, business, care</p> <p>used is I Timothy 3 in reference to elders/ overseers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - elder denotes the dignity of the office - overseer denotes the duties of the office - characteristics - above reproach, hospitable, gentle, peaceable, free from the love of money, manage his household well, good reputation with those outside the church <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I Thes 5:12-13 - they should be appreciated by those who are led - I Peter 5:2-3 - shepherd the flock - exercise oversight - not lording it over them - but by being examples to them - John 13:12-17 - Jesus came to serve and not to be served - this is our example 	<p>I Thes 5:12-13 - Appreciate and esteem them</p> <p>He 13:7, 17 - imitate the faith of those who lead us, submit to them because they keep watch over your souls</p> <p>III John 11 - imitate (copy) what has been shown to us that is good</p> <p>I Timothy 6:11-14 - pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love - fighting the good fight of faith</p> <p>Warnings of bad leaders</p> <p>Phil 3:17-20</p> <p>II Tim 3:1-6, 13</p> <p>II Peter 2:1-3, 12-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - minds are set on earthly things - undisciplined - lazy or they are a burden - those who lord it over you 	<p>#G2941 - kubernesis - to steer, to direct - piloting a ship</p> <p>Acts 27:11 - pilot steers the ship</p> <p>Rev 18:17 - shipmaster</p> <p>I Cor 12:28 - administrations</p> <p>organization, management</p>
