Gatekeepers = Guards - Checked equipment and utensils - Storing and ordering - Maintained the food for the priests and the sacrifices - Cared for the temple furniture - Mixed the incense that was used daily - Account for the gifts that were brought - from individuals, spoils  Gates to the N, S, E, W  Other Posts held by the priests - treasurers - watched over stored valuables - Officers and judges - 6,000 handling judicial functions throughout the land  Time period - 40th year of David's reign (31)	Standing army (1-15) - guard the nation - Guard the temple - 288,000 men/12 divisions - one for each month - If war broke out - more could be called  12 officers names that were responsible for each tribe (16-22) - 12 officers - actually 13 listed (Levi & Aaron, Manasseh is named twice) - two tribes were missing - Asher and Gad  Census mentioned (23-24) - David called for this and was punished - Joab never finished the census (stopped with Benjamin) - This was not included in the Chronicles of King David  Overseers of the agricultural belongings of David (25-31)  Cabinet - those closest to David (32-34) - scribe, counselor, man of understanding - Tutor for the king's sons - Ahithophel - betrayed David and joined Absalom's rebellion - Hushai - pretended loyalty to Absalom but kept David informed on activities - his advice about Absalom's death

Chapter 28-29 - The Temple	I Kings 1-2 - Purging the Enemies of the Kingdom
David announces Solomon's place in the kingdom (28:1-8) - covenant of David's throne established forever - He wanted to build the temple but God chose Solomon - David acknowledges God's choosing him to be king - Solomon will be king after David - Be careful to do what God commands David's Words to Solomon (9-10) - know God and serve Him ALONE - If you seek Him, you will find Him - If you reject Him, He will reject you forever David passes on the plan of the temple complex (11-18) God gave David the plan just as He instructed Moses (19) Solomon charged with construction (20-21) - God will be over the project - He will have everything and every person he needs to accomplish this	
Chapter 29 Building Materials (1-9) - 299 tons of gold - \$25,600,000,000 (in 1650 - \$153,600,000,000,000) - The people offered this so willingly - with a whole heart David's Prayer (10-20) - Thanksgiving - Acknowledging that all this is God's and they are merely giving it back to Him Sacrifices given to God (21-22) Solomon is made king (22-27) - anointed - Takes the throne - People pledge allegiance to Solomon David (27-30) - reigned for 40 years - David dies
