

# The Coming of the Kingdom


Worked in Israel to prevent message from taking root and bearing fruit - Mt 13:18-22

Israel didn't believe declaration of kingdom

Wanted a literal kingdom with our spiritual requirement

Didn't need to repent - they were Abraham's descendants -Mt 3:7-9

They rejected the kingdom

Redeemer had finished the work necessary for God to fulfill His purpose of history

Crushed Satan and his kingdom

# Roman Persecutions

Nero (54-68 AD)

**Turned Christians** into living torches

Military attacks

Paul beheaded, Peter crucified upside down

250 AD - spread

Worship emperor

Get rid of people

Get rid of Bible

Persecution, execution

Spring fertility festival worshiping Ishtar combined with Passover - call it Easter

Pagan winter solstice festivals combined with birth of Christ - Christmas (yule, lights)

Elders transformed from teachers to priests

Celebrate All Hallow's Eve - Halloween - church "christianized" it - celebrate by substituting other things

# Church's Apostasy - Roman Catholic Church

313 AD - Constantine - Edict of Milan - granted total freedom to Christians

Masses of pagans came into the church

Worshiped and prayed

to images

Substitute apostles and martyrs

Church "Christianized"

pagan practices

324 AD - Christianity became favored religion

Adored the queen of heaven

Mary to be adored, worshiped, prayed to

380 AD - only religion allowed in empire

Heathen festivals and blood sacrifices

Communion changed from memorial to sacrifice 42

# **Deeper into Apostasy**

Churches became pagan in practice and membership

Worldly men sought offices for political reasons

Usurped power of state

Not Biblical Christianity - Roman Catholic Church

Gospel becomes more perverted

Saved through faith becomes works

True salvation hidden from the masses

Prevent study of the Bible

Origen - 230 AD allegorical interpretation of Scripture (a moral or hidden meaning)

Made Bible open to anyone's interpretation

This became the norm for the next 1,000 years

# **Deeper into Apostasy**

Look for support outside of Scripture to justify teachings

Bible not only authority

Traditions equal to Bible

Church ultimate authority

No Scripture for laity

Attack on idea of future kingdom

Philosophy rejects the physical realm - its evil

Future physical kingdom must be evil

Origen promotes this leading people to reject God's Word

Jews looked forward to this future kingdom

Jews are wrong - bad

Anything Jewish was heretical

anti-Semitism building

Still some truth being held on to like the deity of Christ

Careful to preserve copies of Scripture

## Augustine - 354-430 AD

Most influential church leader in the east

Caused church to reject future kingdom

Held to Origen's allegorical interpretation

Church of Rome would bring all men into the fold

Anti-Semitic spirit leads to Replacement theology

There is no future place for Israel


Church has replaced Israel

Threatened to conquer all of Europe







# Canonicity Criteria

- the authentication of the writer
- Was it accepted in many different church communities as true doctrine
- Widespread geographical usage
- Content reflected and supported church's belief about Jesus

Scripture doesn't contradict Scripture It is God breathed (II Tim 3:16-17) and not the interpretation of men (II Pe 3:19-21)

Protestant church rejected much apostasy Anabaptists disagreed with persecution

Church and state - separate

Can't force beliefs on others

God protects the movement

Believed in the future kingdom of God




