<p>G#4166 - poimen - shepherd - tends the flock - guiding, guarding, feeding - patience, tenderness, vigilance G#1320 - didaskalos - teacher of truth - teacher needs a student John 10:1-16 - He is door - keeps things in or out, He knows the sheep and the sheep know Him, willing to lay down His life, good Shepherd John 21:15-17 - Peter was called to Agape love which meant a commitment to serving God through serving others I Peter 5:1-5 - shepherd - exercising oversight, voluntarily, according to the will of God, not for gain, with eagerness, not lording it over others, being an example</p> <p>Warning of Bad Shepherds Ezekiel 34</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - not feeding them - They were feeding themselves with the sheep of their own flock - They weren't taking care of the sick but causing the sickness - Scattered for lack of a shepherd and being devoured by the beasts 	<p>Leading - G#4291 - prolitemi - to stand before in rank, to preside, maintain, or be over, to give aid</p> <p>Diligence - G#4710 - sponde - speed, eagerness, earnestness, care</p> <p>I Timothy 3 - elders/overseers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - elder defines the dignity of the office - Overseer defines the duties - Characteristics - above reproach, peaceable, manages household well, good reputation to others outside the church <p>I Peter 5:2-3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - shepherd the flock - Exercise oversight - Not lording it over people - Being examples to all <p>John 13:12-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - servant attitude <p style="text-align: center;">Administration</p> <p>#G2941 - to steer, to direct, to pilot a ship (Acts 27:11; Rev 18:17)</p> <p>Management, organization</p>	<p>I Thes 5:12-13 - appreciate and esteem them - they diligently labor and have charge over you in the Lord Esteeming - rightly appreciate that person Appreciate - respecting and caring for (making sure their needs are met)</p> <p>Heb 13:7, 17 - imitate the faith of those who lead us - submit to the leaders because they keep watch over your soul</p> <p>III John 11 - imitate (copy) what is good and not what is evil</p> <p>I Timothy 6:11-14 - pursuing righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance, gentleness, fight the good fight</p> <p><u>Warning of bad leaders</u> Phil 3:17-20 - set their minds on earthly things - but our citizenship is in heavenly</p> <p>II Tim 3:1-6, 13 - lovers of self and money, not lovers of God, look "godly", deceivers</p> <p>II Peter 2:1-3, 12-19 - exploit with false words</p>
