

## Tabernacle Instructions - Exodus 25-31

Chapter 25:1-9	Chapter 25:10-22
<p>1-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- bring contributions</li> <li>- Heart is to be moved to be part of this</li> <li>- These materials were most likely what have been given to them from the Egyptians</li> <li>- Ex 35:21-29; 36:3-7</li> <li>- Moses issued command for people to stop bring the contribution - had to be refrained from bringing more</li> <li>- Blue, scarlet, purple material - signs of royalty</li> <li>- Blue = shellfish</li> <li>- Purple = secretions of the murex snail</li> <li>- Crimson (scarlet) = powdered egg and bodies of certain worms that feed on the holly plant</li> <li>- Fine linen - Egypt was well known for</li> <li>- Goat hair - livestock they kept - they would know how the process works</li> <li>- Skins - porpoise, badger, dugong, dolphin, sheep, antelope, something extinct</li> <li>- Acacia - strong, hard tree found in the wilderness areas in that part of the world</li> <li>- Spices - balsams that come from Arabia</li> <li>- Construct a sanctuary for God to dwell among His people</li> </ul>	<p>Ark of the Covenant (10-16)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 45" x 27" x 27" size</li> <li>- Overlaid in pure gold</li> <li>- Purity, holiness, godliness of gold</li> <li>- Poles stayed in the ark at all times - to carry the ark</li> <li>- Num 4:15 - don't touch holy object or you will die</li> <li>- II Sam 6:7 - Uzzah is struck dead for not treating God as holy</li> <li>- To put the laws into the ark (He 9:4) - golden pot of manna, Aaron's rod that budded</li> <li>- Laws - people rejected these</li> <li>- God's provision for their needs - rejected God's provision</li> <li>- Miracle, God's authority - people rejected this</li> <li>- Reminder of their sins which deserved judgment</li> </ul> <p>Mercy Seat</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Pure gold - 45" x 27"</li> <li>- One single piece of hammered work</li> <li>- Cherubim faced each other but faces were turned down to the mercy seat</li> <li>- Gen 3:24; Ez 10:1-22; Is 37:16 - Cherubim are the place where God's throne is, and they are the protectors to keep sinful man in his place</li> <li>- Day of Atonement - Yom Kippur - the high priest would sprinkle blood on the mercy seat</li> <li>- James 2:13; He 9:22; He10:1-7; He 9:11-28; He 8:1-13</li> </ul>
