How God Speaks to Us	Begotten of the Father	Contrasts between OT and NT
<p>John 1:1-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- He sent His Word (Jesus)</li> <li>- He was going to be the Light - was going to expose sin</li> <li>- Jesus came to bring us into God's family</li> <li>- He came in flesh</li> </ul> <p>He 1:1-3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Spoke through the Prophets (OT)</li> <li>- Speaks through Jesus</li> </ul> <p>II Peter 1:19-21</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- pay attention as a lamp shines in a dark place</li> <li>- no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation</li> <li>- men moved spoke from God</li> </ul> <p>II Timothy 3:16-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- all Scripture is God-breathed (God through His Spirit spoke and it was written)</li> <li>- teaching, reproof, correction, training in righteousness - so the man of God will be adequate, equipped for every good work</li> </ul>	<p>He 1:5-6 - begotten of the Father, firstborn into the world</p> <p>Ps 2:7 - God refers to Jesus being begotten - but goes on to show how He will rule the world</p> <p>Acts 13:16-39 - That Jesus was raised from the dead and that was when it was said that He was begotten</p> <p>Ro 1:3-4 - Jesus was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead</p> <p>Rev 1:5 - Jesus is firstborn from the dead (I Cor 15:20; Col 1:18)</p>	<p>Israel had their prophets Christ the Word made flesh</p> <p>Moses made the tabernacle Christ made everything</p> <p>The Law showed a shadow of things Christ brought the light which showed all things</p> <p>Moses bore the burden of Israel Christ upholds the world</p> <p>Blood of animals reminded of sin Jesus takes away sin</p> <p>The priests constantly worked Christ sat down</p> <p>Israel is God's people Through Christ we are God's children</p>
