<p>I am of flesh Sold into bondage to sin (14) Not practicing what I would like to do, doing the things that I hate (15) If I do what I do not wish to do, I agree with the Law (16) I am not doing it, but sin which dwells in me (17) Nothing good dwells in me Wishing is present, the doing of good is not (18) Practice the very evil I do not wish (19) Not I doing it but the sin that dwells in me (20) Principle that evil is present in me (21) I am a prisoner of the law of sin in my members (23) Who will save me? - Jesus Christ (24-25)</p>	<p>We died to sin (6:2) Old self was crucified, body of sin was done away with, no longer slaves to sin (6:6) No is no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus (8:1) The Law of the Spirit has set you free from the law of sin and death (8:2) we are not under obligation to live according to the flesh (8:12)</p> <p>I John 3:8-9 - we cannot live in sin if we are born of God</p> <p>I John 2:19 - when they remain with us (Christians) it shows that they were of us</p>	<p>Problem - Phil 3:2-6 - before salvation Paul viewed himself as righteous</p> <p>Problem - Acts 26:1-14 - he was the most righteous</p>	<p>Through the Law comes the knowledge of sin (3:20)</p> <p>Man is justified by faith, apart from the works of the Law (3:28)</p> <p>Died to the Law, to be joined to Christ to bear fruit to God (7:4)</p> <p>Died to the Law - now serve in newness of the Spirit not the oldness of the letter (7:6)</p> <p>II Cor 3:6 - servants to a new covenant , not the letter but of the Spirit</p> <p>II Cor 3:18 - transformed from glory to glory into the image of the Lord</p>
