| <p>God's idea</p> <p>the earth would be destroyed but Noah and family and animals would be saved</p> <p>God's promise - He would never destroy the earth by flood again</p> <p>Sign was a rainbow</p> <p>everlasting covenant</p> | <p>Gen 15 - God started it</p> <p>Promise - heir, descendants, land</p> <p>Cut covenant - cut the animals in two - placed them opposite of each other - smoking oven and flaming torch pass through the pieces</p> <p>Everlasting covenant</p> <p>Gen 17 - sign was circumcision name change</p> <p>Isaac was the son of promise</p> | <p>Exodus 24<br/>God's idea</p> <p>came through Moses to the people</p> <p>Covenant of Laws</p> <p>Built an altar - sacrifice - blood was sprinkled</p> <p>they ate and drank</p> <p>No time given</p> | <p>Gen 21:22-34<br/>Abimelech's idea</p> <p>he wants peace</p> <p>terms - Abraham was to treat he and his people kindly</p> <p>Sign<br/>7 lambs<br/>planted tamarisk tree</p> | <p>Gen 31:43-54<br/>Laban</p> <p>peace - not doing harm to his daughters</p> <p>pillars - heaps - Mizpah - God was watching</p> <p>eating and drinking</p> | <p>Jesus initiates covenant of the blood and body of Jesus Christ (Luke 22:17-20)</p> <p>bread = Jesus' body<br/>wine = His blood</p> <p>Is 42:5-9 - Jesus was the one who was appointed as a covenant for the people</p> <p>Mal 3:1-2 - Messenger of the Covenant (Jesus) was coming</p> |
